UCSD PRESENTS ANNUAL UNDERGRADUATE ARTS FESTIVAL

The yearly Undergraduate Arts Festival at the University of California, San Diego is an opportunity for students to demonstrate and exhibit original works. This year the event will extend from May 29-June 8.

The Department of Visual Arts events will kick off on Wednesday, May 30, at noon in the Price Center Plaza. The performance art vehicle, The Blue Band, will make a presentation; students will also take part in the event.

The photography exhibition and seniors art show will extend from May 29-June 1, in the Mandeville Center East Room (noon-4 p.m.) and the Mandeville Annex Gallery (noon-5 p.m.), respectively.

The All-Student Exhibition will take place from June 4-8 in the Mandeville Annex Gallery, from noon to 5 p.m. The Video Festival will take place from May 31-June 1 in the Price Center Gallery B.

The Undergraduate Students' Film Festival will take place on June 6, at 7 p.m., in Peterson Hall, Third College, room 108. This event will be a compilation of original films which have been directed and filmed by UCSD students, both independently and through visual arts projects.

The Students' Outdoor Installations will be located in various places on campus. Maps will be available at the Visual Arts Department, Mandeville Center, room 217.

Parking permits are required on campus.
