

Dean Stokes resigns

Dr. Joseph Stokes III has resigned as Dean of the School of Medicine at the University of California, San Diego and has accepted the chairmanship of the School's Department of Preventive Medicine, Chancellor John S. Galbraith announced today.

Since his appointment in 1963, Dean Stokes has devoted his efforts to planning and recruitment for the School of Medicine, which is scheduled to admit its first class of 32 students in the fall of 1968.

"Dean Stokes and his associates have developed a plan for a school of the highest quality which will be integrated with campus-wide departments. We shall continue to be guided by the philosophy he has expressed, and I am pleased that he will continue to be centrally involved in the development of medical education and research at UCSD," Chancellor Galbraith said.
