

UCSD named to receive E. I. du Pont de Nemours and Company educational aid grant

The University of California, San Diego is one of 165 U.S. colleges and universities named to receive educational aid grants for 1974 from E. I. du Pont de Nemours and Company.

The San Diego campus received a \$7,500 Du Pont Science and Engineering Grant in Chemistry designed to support science and engineering research and teaching. The grant is given with maximum flexibility in its use allowing the department to help meet needs and undertake work which would not be possible otherwise.

The 1974 Du Pont educational aid grants total nearly \$3 million, the largest annual contribution in the 57-year history of the company's aid-to-education program. The majority of the increased funds in the 1974 program will be used in support of mechanical and chemical engineering education and to stimulate student interest, particularly among minority groups, in science and engineering careers.
