UCSD OPPORTUNITIES ABROAD FAIR TO BE HELD ON OCT. 18

The International Center at the University of California, San Diego will hold its sixth annual "Quest International," a study, work and travel abroad information fair, on Friday, Oct. 18 from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

This year's fair will bring representatives from over 30 international programs to UCSD to meet with interested students, staff, faculty and members of the community. Representatives from a wide variety of university study abroad programs, volunteer work programs, and paid work programs will be on hand to provide information about work and study options for students and others.

Quest International will include a special international lunch from 11:30 a.m. to 1 p.m. for \$2.00.
