Thirty members of the University of California, San Diego's Mandeville Gallery Art Council took part in a four-day tour that included visits to five private art collections and a tour of the General Mills collection in Minneapolis, Minnesota.

The trip, which was organized by Art Council members Joan Wiener and Patty Brutton, was from June 17-20, and included a stay at the Nicollet Island Inn, situated on the banks of the Mississippi River.

Members visited five private collections: The Dayton, Bernstein, Winton, Davis and Fiterman, all of which are housed in the homes of the collectors.

The group was hosted by General Mills executives at a luncheon, followed by a tour of the company's extensive art collection.

Also included in the itinerary was a visit to the Walker Art Center and Sculpture Collection and a tour of the Fredrick Weisman Gallery at the University of Minnesota.
