EVENT: Explomet '90 -- International conference on shock- wave and high-strain-rate phenomena in materials.

DATE: August 12-17

LOCATION: Price Center Auditorium

PROGRAM: Between 150 to 200 scientists and engineers, including about a dozen representatives from the Soviet Union, will listen to the latest reports on the synthesis and behavior of new materials created by explosion or compaction.

Materials science is an important and rapidly growing field, with applications in commerce and defense. The international flavor of the meeting is underscored by the presentation of an award to two scientists Wednesday evening, Mark Wilkins from the United States, and Andrei Deribas from the Soviet Union.
