Gentlemen: -

After our telephone conversation of this morning
I looked up your record in our books and find that since June
1914 your payments have been on the following dates:

June 16, 1914 July 8. Aug. 10. Sept. 8. Oct. 12. Nov. 13, Dec. 10. 9, 1915 Feb. Hoh. 11. Apr. 21. 11, Hay June 10. July 15. Aug. 10, Sept. 8. Oct. 11. Nov. 15.

Was that with the exception of the payment for December and January mater, which was made on February 9th, that there had only been one month in which you had failed to pay before the 10th. The record as shown by our books does not agree with this statement, but shows that there had been eight months since June 1914 when your bills have been delinquent. Under the circumstances I do not see any other way out except for you to make the deposit as required in the circular letter of recent date.


