EVENT: News conference where UCSD Chancellor Richard C. Atkinson and San Diego Community College District Board President Gene. French will announce and sign an agreement to guarantee City College, Mesa College and Miramar College students admission to UCSD as juniors upon completion of, the associate degree. This is the first agreement of its kind in Southern California between a community college district and a University of California campus, and only the second in the state.

The first students from Miramar College to receive the guarantee will be identical twins (one will be wearing a UCSD T-shirt, and the other a Miramar College T-shirt) who graduated from Mira Mesa High School on June 16 and will attend Miramar College in the fall.
