Dear Mrs. Cherin,

The following is for your information in connection with my will.

(1) I have a bank account in Germany in my own name, no. 187067/95 with the Dresdner Bank, Frankfurt a/M, Gallus Anlage 7. My wife has power of attorney for this account.

The German Government transfers to this account each month my "pension". There is never very much money in this account because I transfer the balance from time to time to my New York Account with the Chase Manhattan Bank at 25 Broadway, New York City.

(2) I have a Checking Account in New York with the Chase Manhattan Bank, 25 Broadway, and they also hold for me at the present time some U.S. Bonds or Notes in their Trust Department.

(3) I have a Checking Account with the Chase Manhattan Bank, 1140 Broadway. My salary from the University of Chicago is regularly transferred to this account. My accountant, George Shimmerlik at 1140 Broadway has power of attorney for this account and he draws on this account to pay my hospital bills and such other bills as I transmit to him for payment.

(4) My regular income comes from the University of Chicago under a research grant of the National Institutes of Health. This grant pays my salary. It also pays my travel expenses, including my hotel bills

in the United States - outside of Chicago - and it pays for secretarial services.

(5) My "pension" in Germany is based on: Wiedergutmachungsbescheid des Herrn Bundesministers des Inneren vom 22. Oktober 1957- II. W 2-4. 3. Szi.-N-. My "pension" will stop on my death but my wife is entitled to a "pension" which amounts to 40% of 75% of what the German Government has been paying me. In case of my death the address of the office to notify is as follows: Oberfinanzdirektion Duesseldorf, Abteilung fuer Zoelle und Verbrauchsteuern, Duesseldorf, West Germany.

(6) My secretary at the University of Chicago can help out with any matters dealing with the University. She is Mrs. Noreen Mann. Her address is: The Research Institutes, the University of Chicago, Chicago 37, Illinois. She can be reached over the telephone at extension 3715 at MIDway 3-0800.


As we discussed, I have prepared and enclose herewith a list of Savings Banks in the City of New York, insured by the F.I.D.C. If you secretary calls the banks you select they will mail you the appropriate forms for the opening of an account.

I also enclose herewith the form of affidavit required by the New York State Tax Commission in cases where no residence is alleged of a decedent whose will is probated in New York. I would appreciate your supplying me with the general information requested in the said form.

I checked to ascertain the general cost involved in buying and selling U.S. Treasury Bonds. I was advised that the expense depends upon the amount of Treasury Bonds purchased, for example one bond of \$1,000.00 would cost about \$2.50 to buy and a like amount to sell, ten bonds \$1.25 to buy and to sell, and fifty bonds approximately \$.32 to buy and a like amount to sell.

If there is any information in addition to the above which you require, please do not hesitate to call upon me.

Today I received the original of the enclosed Thermofax copy of letter addressed to you by Metropolitan Life Insurance Company, together with your above identified policy.


I am retaining the policy with your other personal papers for the time being.


Dear Doctor Szilard:


Dear Dr. Szilard:
