August 30.

"UC San Diego Health System is the one place in our region where patients from across the U.S. benefit from the integration of compassionate care and evidenced-based medicine in every interaction," said Tom Jackiewicz, CEO, UC San Diego Health System. "Our physicians, surgeons, scientists, nurses and staff come together as a team to treat the most difficult diseases, offering the most novel treatments and procedures and – where possible – lifesaving cures."

The core mission of "Best Hospitals" is to help guide patients who need an especially high level of care because of a difficult surgery, a challenging condition, or added risk because of age or

other health problems. "These are referral centers where other hospitals send their sickest patients," said Avery Comarow, *U.S. News & World Report* Health Rankings Editor. "Hospitals like these are ones you or those close to you should consider when the stakes are high."

The latest rankings showcase 720 hospitals out of about 5,000 hospitals nationwide. Each is ranked among the country's top hospitals in at least one medical specialty and/or ranked among the best hospitals in its metro area.

"These are hospitals we call 'high performers.' They are fully capable of giving most patients first-rate care, even if they have serious conditions or need demanding procedures," Comarow said. "Almost every major metro area has at least one of these hospitals."

UC San Diego Health System includes two hospitals and multiple primary and specialty care outpatient centers in Hillcrest, La Jolla and Scripps Ranch. The 10-story, multi-specialty Jacobs Medical Center will break ground in March of 2012.

- Overall rankings: The 22nd annual to *U.S. News & World Report* rankings recognize hospitals in 94 metro areas and 16 specialties, which include: cancer; diabetes and endocrinology; ear, nose, and throat; gastroenterology; geriatrics; gynecology; cardiology and heart surgery; nephrology; neurology and neurosurgery; ophthalmology; orthopedics; psychiatry; pulmonology; rehabilitation; rheumatology; and urology.
