

Sixty young musicians from UCLA will play a Wind concert of band music at Sherwood Hall on March 21

Sixty young musicians will come from the University of California, Los Angeles, Wednesday night, March 21, to play a concert of band music at Sherwood Hall, Art Center in La Jolla.

Most of them are members of the UCLA band, which won international acclaim on its European voyage last year. It played at Denmark's famous Fourth of July celebration, the largest held outside the United States.

Two of the soloists are students from the San Diego area. They are Antoinette Mizisin, oboist, whose parents are Mr. and Mrs. Andrew Mizisin and Kenneth Schei, trumpeter, son of Mr. and Mrs. Ben I. Schei.

The group is being brought to La Jolla by the University's Committee for Intercampus Arts Exchange. Tickets are \$1.00 for students, \$2.00 general admission. They are available at University Extension, in downtown San Diego, at the Art Center in La Jolla, and on the San Diego campus of the University.
