

"Hall Pass" depicts artists' freedom of choice

The collective work of photographers Carlos Reyes and Roberto Gutierrez will be exhibited from Nov. 5-16 in a show called, "Hall Pass," at the University of California, San Diego Grove Gallery.

Extensive travel through the United States and Mexico set the stage for the photographs in this exhibition. The two photographers have also included works from a project commissioned by the Mexican Department of Tourism.

Reyes says, "Our combined efforts work very well together. Roberto's images have been strongly influenced by his background in video and dance. My photographs are mostly of people. I want to convey the dignity that they possess."

Reyes was born in New York City and reared in Mexico City. He has had many solo and group shows in this country, and has done extensive magazine photography.

Gutierrez was born in Mazatlan, Mexico, and grew up in San Diego. He is a recent UCSD graduate. He has had several of his photographs shown at the Centro Cultural de la Raza in San Diego. This will be his first show with Reyes.
