TWO COLLECTIONS OF ANSEL ADAMS' PHOTOGRAPHS TO BE SHOWN AT THE MANDEVILLE GALLERY FROM MARCH 2-APRIL 7

Two collections of prints taken by the late photographer Ansel Adams, titled "Ansel Adams: Fiat Lux" and "Ansel Adams: The Museum Set," will be shown in the Mandeville Gallery at the University of California, San Diego, from March 2-April 7. An opening reception will take place at the gallery from 7-9 p.m., March 1. The "Fiat Lux" collection contains 100 photographs, taken of the University of California campuses, research stations, natural reserve systems and agricultural units during the mid-1960s for its centennial. The photographs have never been on exhibition prior to their debut at UC Irvine in January, 1991. "The Museum Set" contains 75 photographs, which Adams felt best represented his life's work.
