UCSD TO OFFER NONPROFIT GROUPS INFORMATION ON RECYCLING PROGRAMS

A workshop to assist nonprofit organizations in starting recycling programs as fund-raisers will be hosted by the University of California, San Diego, from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Oct. 17 in the Price Center Ballroom. The event is sponsored by the California Resource Recovery Association.

Among groups invited to attend are PTA's, environmental clubs, churches, YMCA's and YWCA's, Boys and Girls clubs and service organizations.

Speakers will include local government and private industry experts on recycling programs, markets for recyclables and public education.

Topics will include: how to get a program up and running, with examples of successful programs; marketing materials, including tips on local buybacks; how to effectively use the media, and keeping the records straight--accounting and documentation.
