

Faculty members receive grants from American Cancer Society to pursue research into causes and cures for the dread disease

Seven members of the University of California, San Diego faculty have received grants from the American Cancer Society totalling more than \$450,000 to pursue their research into causes and cures for the dread disease.

Those receiving awards and the amounts: Milton H. Saier, Jr., biology (\$66,396); Bruno H. Zimm, Revelle College (\$49,979); Nathan O. Kaplan, Revelle College (\$115,000); Richard W. Dutton, biology (\$99,546); John E. Bergmann, biology (\$24,219); E. Peter Geiduschek, biology (70,000), And Hoi Sang U, biology (12,000).

In addition to the seven researchers, four members of the UC San Diego School of Medicine Faculty also received grants from the American Cancer Society.
