

Friends of the Library book sale

May 3, 1979

Book bargains will be available to the bibliophilic buyer from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Saturday, May 12, on the plaza at the entrance of the Central University Library at the University of California, San Diego.

More than 8,000 books covering a wide variety of topics will be on sale at the annual Friends of the Library Book Sale. Most of the books are clothbound volumes donated by the community specifically for the sale, and many are books owned by the library which are no longer needed by the library.

The majority of books will be sold for one dollar each, and the first three hours of the sale generally are busy, so buyers should come early for the best selection, according to a library spokesperson. Most of the books, including volumes on subjects such as politics, history, physical science, language, social science and psychology, will be put out for sale early in the day.

Profits from the sale will benefit the UC San Diego libraries.
