

UCSD receives research grants totalling \$145,102

Research grants totalling \$145,102 were recently awarded to members of the Departments of Biology, Psychology and Aerospace and Mechanical Engineering Sciences at the University of California, San Diego.

Dr. Warren L. Butler, professor of biology, received a grant from the Department of Health, Education and Welfare, Public Health Service, for continuing support of his study of "Photochemical Mechanism of Photosynthesis."

Dr. John H. Taylor, a researcher in the Department of Psychology, was awarded a grant from the National Aeronautics and Space Administration for his project, "Investigation of Sensitivity of Central and Peripheral Fields."

The Department of Health, Education and Welfare, P.H.S., awarded a grant to Dr. Benjamin W. Zweifach, professor of bioengineering, for his study-of "Structure and Function of Microcirculation."

The Ford Foundation awarded a faculty research fellowship to Ramachandra Ramanathan, assistant professor of economics, for a study of "Indian Saving Behavior."
