

First quarter gifts and endowments total \$339,572

Gifts and endowments totalling \$339,572 were received by UCSD during the first quarter of 1971, Acting Chancellor Herbert F. York announced today.

The contributions, made by a total of 170 donors, included \$216,513 for medical research. Twenty-one of the gifts were from UCSD faculty members, who gave a total of \$2,645 during the period.

One \$600 contribution came from the La Jolla Civic Orchestra and Chorus Association, assigned to the department of music for tuition scholarships. The Mandeville Foundation gave 43,000 as final payment of a \$226,000 grant over a five-year period to support acquisitions for the Don Cameron Allen collection of Renaissance literature in the UCSD library. The Foundation also pledged another five years of support to this acquisition program.

Among numerous gifts earmarked for the School of Medicine and University Hospital was one from Mr. and Mrs. Harry E. Farb of \$5,000 to establish radiation therapy facilities at the hospital. Another gift of \$3,000 came from Mr. and Mrs. Harry J. Ragen to support work of the Learning Disability Clinic at the hospital. Other grants included one of \$5,000 from Calbiochem to the chemistry department for spectrophotometric research.
