Its uses, juices a n d abuses


A paper read by Horace G. Platt, at *Bohemian Club High Jinks*, October 13, 1900




R. SIRE: "The Grape: Its Juices, Uses and Abuses,"






On gently sloping hills, in nestling vales, kissed by the sun, begemmed with the dew, and caressed by the rustling leaves, grows the enpurpling grape.
