

## **Shirley Strum lectures on "Sexual Politics in Baboon Society" as part of the "Adventures in Research" lecture series**

A fascinating look at the social life of a troupe of African baboons will be the subject of the final "Adventures in Research" lecture at the University of California, San Diego Wednesday, May 27, at noon in Conference Room 111A.

Shirley Strum, assistant professor of anthropology, will present an illustrated lecture titled "Sexual Politics in Baboon Society" based on several years of research with a baboon troupe in Kenya.

Dr. Strum, a graduate of the University of California, Berkeley, has been featured in National Geographic Magazine and recently completed a documentary film about her work which will be shown on British television this year.

The "Adventures in Research" lectures are designed to better acquaint the campus community and the general public with current research projects by UC San Diego faculty members. The series is sponsored by the Council of Provosts, the Public Information Office and Third College.
