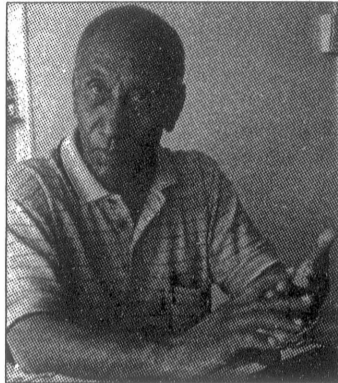

MONETARY POLICY STATEMENT

BY THE GOVERNOR OF THE BANK OF PAPUA NEW GUINEA,
MR. L. WILSON KAMIT, CBE

PORT MORESBY 31 July 2007

Objective of Monetary Policy

The objective of monetary policy in Papua New Guinea (PNG) is to achieve and maintain price stability. This entails low inflation supported by stable interest and exchange rates. If achieved, price stability will lead to:

- Confidence in the kina exchange rate and management of the economy;
- A foundation for stable fiscal operations of the Government;
- Certainty for businesses to plan for long-term investment; and
- A stable macroeconomic environment conducive to economic growth.

Executive Summary

The Government maintained fiscal discipline in its fiscal operations for the first five months of 2007. Based on the annual inflation to March 2007 of 4.5 percent, projections by the Bank of Papua New Guinea (Bank) indicate that inflation for the year will be 6.0 to 8.0 percent. The increase in inflation was due to the depreciation of the kina against the Australian dollar, combined with the high growth in monetary aggregates. The Bank is concerned that inflationary pressures will arise in the second half of 2007. The Bank will therefore monitor the situation closely, including reviewing the June quarter inflation and fiscal outcomes before deciding on its monetary policy stance for the second half of 2007.

The main risks to price stability in the second half of 2007 are further depreciation of the kina against the Australian dollar, imported inflation from PNG's major trading partner countries, declines in prices of PNG's exports, further fast expansion of monetary aggregates and any fiscal slippages. Fiscal discipline by the incoming Government is important to ensure that macroeconomic stability continues over the medium-term, without which the Bank will have great difficulties in mitigating the inflationary pressures.

Monetary aggregates are expected to continue to grow strongly in the second half of 2007 as a result of increases in net foreign assets and private sector credit. The low official interest rates are a contributing factor to the fast growth in monetary aggregates. The fast growth in monetary aggregates might exert further inflationary pressures, the Bank will therefore see to it that the growth in monetary aggregates is non-inflationary.

The Bank is committed to achieving and maintaining price stability. The neutral monetary policy stance that the Bank maintains will be reassessed subject to the June quarter inflation and fiscal outcomes and, if necessary, changes to it will be made to counter any adverse effects on the achievement of price stability in the second half of 2007.

1.0 Monetary Policy Discussions

1.1 Monetary Policy Assessment and Issues

In the first half of 2007, the Bank continued its neutral monetary policy stance. The Kina Facility Rate (KFR) was maintained at 6.0 percent.

The annual headline inflation of 4.5 percent in March 2007 is within the 2007 forecast stated in the January MPS, as a result of the low prices of seasonal produce. Based on this inflation outcome, expected exchange rate movements, imported inflation from PNG's major trading partners, the lagged effect of past increases in fuel prices and fast expansion of monetary aggregates, inflation is now projected by the Bank to be 6.0 to 8.0 percent for 2007.

The Trade Weighted Index (TWI) and Real Effective Exchange Rate (REER) declined over the same period mainly reflecting the weakening of the kina

against the Australian dollar. The depreciation of the REER also indicates a general improvement in the terms of trade of PNG's exports.

The low interest rate environment combined with sustained business confidence led to increased lending to the private sector by other depository corporations (ODCs). The increase in lending enabled the private sector to expand business activity, employment and consumption. Given the projected increase in inflation and low interest rates, real interest rates could turn negative and lead to capital outflow.

Annual growth in broad money supply (M3*) and the monetary base were 35.1 percent and 12.9 percent, respectively, to June 2007. The growth in broad money supply was primarily attributed to an increase in net foreign assets of the Central Bank and net claims on the private sector by ODCs. Whilst, the Bank was able to partly sterilise excess liquidity caused by the build up in net foreign assets of the Central Bank, interest rates remained low. The faster growth in monetary aggregates contributed to the inflationary pressure.

The Government achieved a budget surplus for the first five months of 2007, reflecting tighter controls on its expenditure compared to previous election years. This, combined with the slow drawdown from the trust accounts, has assisted the Bank in mitigating inflationary pressures. In this regard, the incoming Government should maintain fiscal discipline to ensure that macroeconomic stability continues over the medium-term, without which the Bank will have great difficulties in mitigating the inflationary pressures.

1.2 Monetary Policy Stance

The Bank of Papua New Guinea (Bank) is concerned about the increase in inflation in the first quarter of 2007, due to the depreciation of the kina against the Australian dollar and the fast growth in monetary aggregates. The Bank would monitor these developments closely and adjust its monetary policy stance to ensure that price stability is achieved.

Based on the assumptions that inflation will be 6.0 to 8.0 percent, further depreciation of the kina exchange rate against the currencies of PNG's major trading partners and fast expansion of monetary aggregates, a change in monetary policy stance will be warranted. This will be subject to the inflation and fiscal outcomes for the June quarter.

The Bank expects broad money supply to grow by 27.9 percent and the monetary base to grow by 7.7 percent in 2007. These increases are mainly due to the projected growth in net foreign assets of the Central Bank, net claims on the private sector by ODCs and low official interest rates. These factors combined with sustained business confidence led to an expansion of business activity and employment on one hand and exerted inflationary pressures on the other hand.

Based on the projected inflation, official interest rates are low, and there is a potential that real interest rates might become negative, which could lead to capital outflow.

The Bank expects the incoming Government to continue to prudently manage its fiscal operations in the second half of 2007 and remain within the parameters of the National Budget and the Medium Term Development Strategy (MTDS). The surplus should be used to retire debt. The Government should also improve efficiency in the implementation of development expenditure in the priority areas of health, education, law and order and physical infrastructure. The continuation of public sector reforms, improving the efficiency of public utilities and the removal of impediments to trade and investment will also contribute to higher economic activity and growth in PNG, and assist in absorbing the increasing domestic demand. At this stage of PNG's development, it should aim for economic growth of 6.0 to 7.0 percent to ensure that the great majority of the population benefits from the mineral boom the country is enjoying.

The risks to price stability over the medium term could come from:

- Further depreciation of the kina against the Australian dollar;
- High inflation imported from PNG's major trading partner countries;
- Further fast growth of the monetary aggregates;
- Decline in export commodity prices;
- Any fiscal slippages by the National Government;
- Lagged effect and further increases in oil prices; and
- Other unforeseen external and domestic shocks.

In this respect, the Bank will closely monitor these risks and their potential effects on the achievement of price stability and, if necessary, make adjustments to the stance of monetary policy in the second half of 2007 and over the medium-term.

1.3 Conduct of Monetary Policy

The Monetary Policy Statement (MPS) provides the overall monetary policy framework, while the monthly Kina Facility Rate (KFR) remains the instrument for signalling the Bank's monetary policy stance through an announcement by the Governor. Monetary policy will be conducted within the monetary base framework. Following the announcement, Open Market Operations (OMOs) will be conducted to support the Bank's monetary policy stance. The OMOs involves Repurchase Agreement (Repo) transactions with commercial banks and the auction of Central Bank Bills (CBB) to ODCs and Treasury bills to the general public.

The Bank is committed to adopting appropriate monetary policy management strategies that will achieve price stability.

2.0 Developments and Expectations

2.1 International Developments

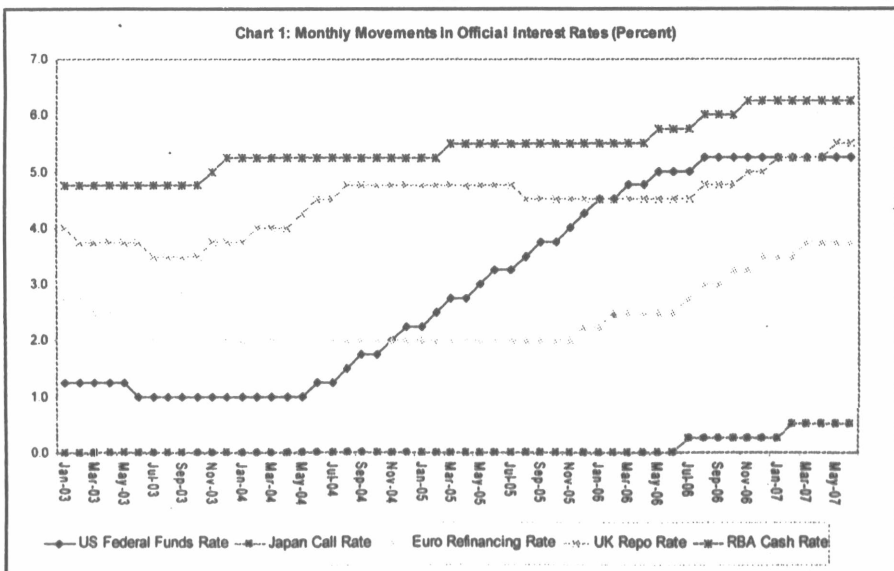
World economic growth is expected to remain strong this year according to the April 2007 World Economic Outlook (WEO), by the International Monetary Fund (IMF). In 2007, the world economy is expected to expand by 4.9 percent compared with 5.4 percent in 2006. Emerging market economies, especially China and India, are the main forces behind this growth, while the Japanese economy continues to recover.

In the US, economic growth, which continued to slow during the first quarter of 2007, was influenced by the ongoing weakness in the housing sector. In 2007, growth is expected to slow to 2.2 percent from 3.3 percent in 2006. In 2007, the Eurozone economy is expected to grow by 2.3 percent compared to 2.6 percent in 2006. The growth in 2006 was supported by strong domestic demand. The Japanese economy is projected to grow by 2.7 percent in 2007 from 2.6 percent in 2006. Rapid growth amongst the emerging economies have been led by China and India, which recorded annual growth rates of 10.7 and 9.2 percent in 2006, and are expected to grow by 10.0 and 8.4 percent, respectively in 2007.

The risks to this global outlook include the potential for a further slow down in the US economy reducing global demand increased volatility in the financial markets, inflationary pressures and global trade imbalances.

Strong economic growth and high commodity and energy prices continue to underpin global inflationary pressures. Oil prices continued to consolidate between US\$60 to US\$70 per barrel during the second half of 2006. Although global headline inflation declined from its peak in 2006, major economies continue to experience high inflation rates close to the upper end of their central banks' inflation targets. As a result, the European Central Bank, Bank of England and Bank of Japan increased their official interest rates during the first half of 2007. In the US, despite the slow down in the economy, the Federal Reserve Board left the Federal Funds Rate unchanged (see Chart 1).

Global financial markets continue to experience volatile trading conditions. In the foreign exchange market, the US dollar and the Japanese Yen continued to weaken against the other major currencies. The US dollar weakened on the back of the slow down in the US economy. This led to expectations that the Federal Reserve Board would lower interest rates in future. The weakness of the Yen was due to low interest rates and expectations that the Bank of Japan would delay any rise in interest rates this year. Commodity-based currencies like the Australian and New Zealand dollars appreciated to record highs supported by

carry-trade activities. Global equity markets continued to perform strongly, supported by strong corporate profits while bond yields were higher reflecting greater risk premiums relating to global inflation and on the back of monetary policy tightening by major central banks.

2.2 Domestic Economic Conditions

The growth in employment in 2006 continued during the March quarter of 2007. Data from the Bank's Employment Survey shows that employment grew by 4.1 percent in the March quarter of 2007, compared to 3.7 percent in the December quarter of 2006. This was due to higher employment in all sectors except the 'financial/business and other services' sector. Annual employment growth was 9.9 percent to March 2007, compared to 8.8 percent to December 2006. Growth in private sector activity, combined with Government spending and higher consumer demand, indicates that real GDP growth could be higher than the Government's forecast of 4.5 percent in 2007.

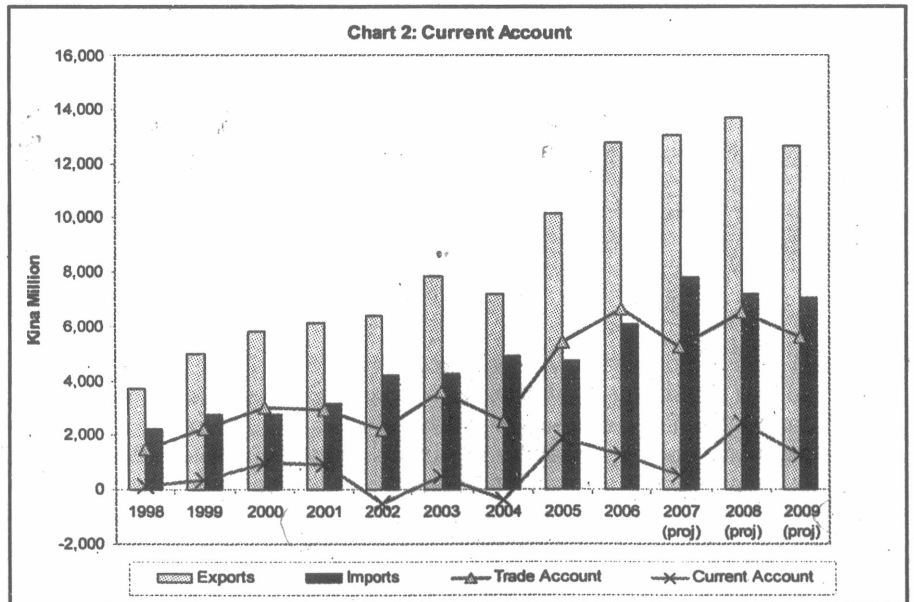
Over the medium term, addressing key policy issues regarding impediments to business and investment, promoting export-led growth, improving public infrastructures and institutional reforms should promote further economic growth.

2.3 Balance of Payments

Preliminary balance of payments data for the five months to May 2007 showed an overall surplus of K342.4 million, compared to a surplus of K499.1 million in the corresponding period of 2006. This outcome was due to a deficit in the current account balance, which was more than offset by a surplus in the capital and financial accounts. The deficit in the current account was due to a lower trade surplus and higher net service payments. The surplus in the capital and financial accounts was the result of net inflows in both the capital and financial accounts, reflecting direct project financing by donor agencies, net equity inflows of direct and portfolio investments and the sale of financial derivative instruments.

The level of gross foreign exchange reserves at the end of May 2007 was US\$1,547.7 (K4,687.1) million, sufficient for 8.5 months of total and 16.1 months of non-mineral import covers. As at 25th July 2007, the level of gross foreign exchange reserves was US\$1,623.7 (K4,706.4) million.

The latest IMF and World Bank price projections indicated that most international prices of PNG's non-mineral exports will be higher in 2007, compared to 2006. According to the mineral companies, prices of all mineral exports are expected to increase, with the exception of crude oil.

The export volumes of PNG's major commodities are projected to increase in 2007, compared to 2006. The projected increases are mainly due to lagged supply responses of improved prices for some non-mineral commodities and higher production associated with favourable weather conditions, harvesting of new plantings coming to maturity from new plantations and from the Autonomous Region of Bougainville. These developments in non-mineral export volumes are expected to continue into the medium-term. The projected increase in gold production is due to the mining of higher ore grades from existing mines combined with commencement of production from the Simberi and Sinivit gold mines. The projected increase in crude oil production is due to higher production from the South East (SE) Mananda oil project.

Other main assumptions underlying the balance of payments projections for 2007 and the medium term include:

- A stable kina exchange rate;
- The commencement of production from the Simberi and Sinivit gold mines in 2007; and
- The continued construction of the Ramu Nickel mine to 2008 and the commencement of production in 2009.

The surplus in the balance of payments is projected to be lower at K1,090.2 million in 2007, compared to a surplus of K1,976.8 million in 2006. At the end of 2007, it is projected that gross foreign exchange reserves will be around US\$1,800.0 (K5,400.0) million, sufficient for 8.4 months of total and 14.9 months of non-mineral import covers. The gross foreign exchange reserves are projected to increase further over the medium term (see Appendix).

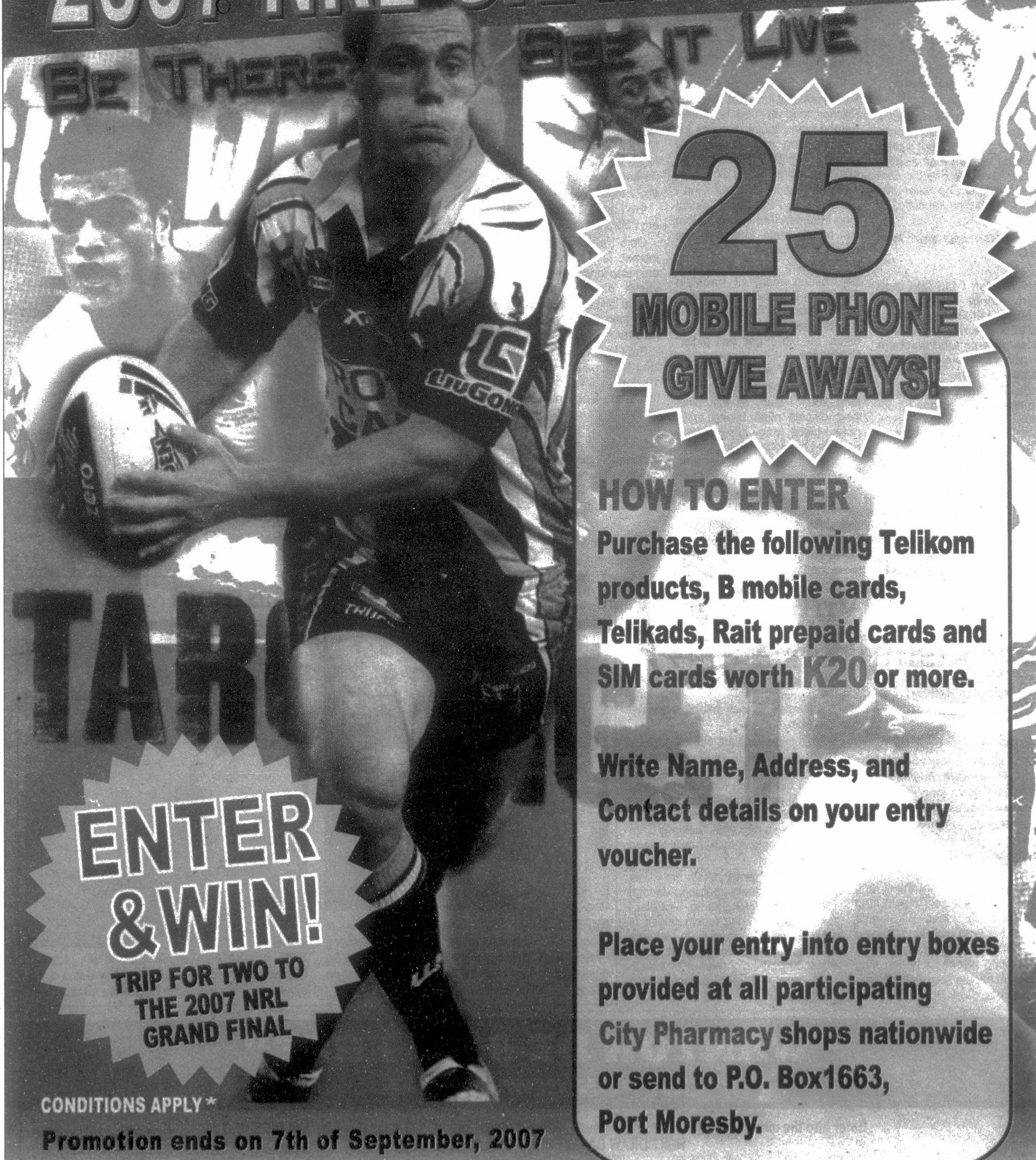

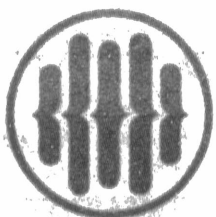

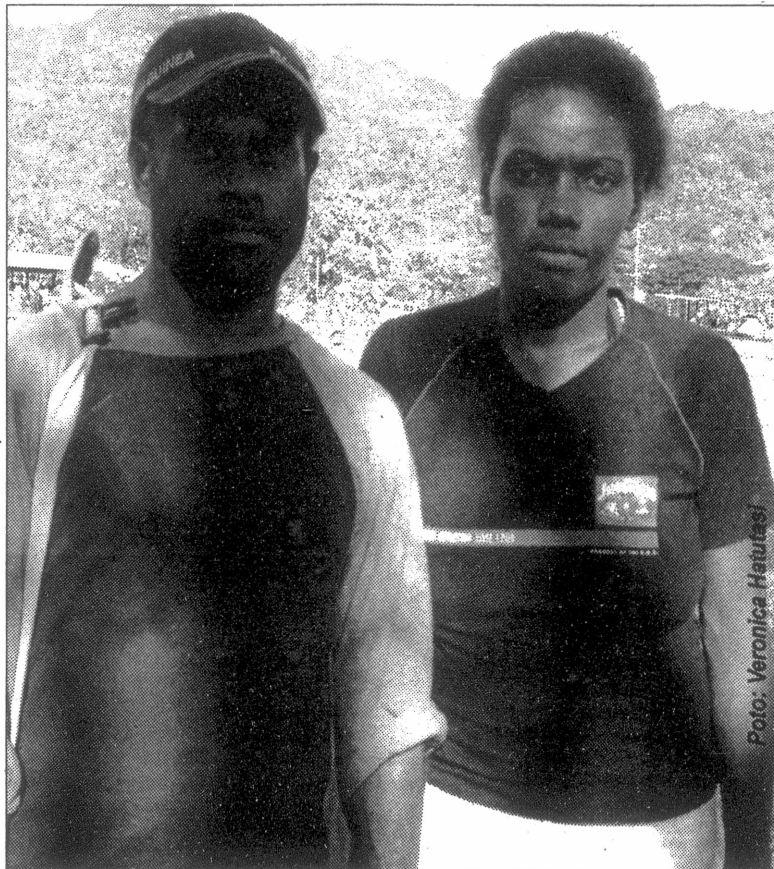

2.4 Fiscal Operations of the Central Government

Preliminary estimates of the fiscal operations of the National Government over the five months to May 2007 showed an overall budget surplus of K514.0 million, compared to a deficit of K225.9 million in the corresponding period of 2006. This represents 2.9 percent of nominal GDP. The surplus reflected higher tax receipts, combined with lower expenditure. The budget surplus was used to repay net overseas and domestic loans of K71.4 million and K442.5 million, respectively.

The Government continued to redeem Treasury bills and issue Inscribed stocks. During the first half of 2007, the net retirement of Treasury bills was K337.5 million, while net issuance of Inscribed stocks totalled K203.5 million.

2.5 Exchange Rate

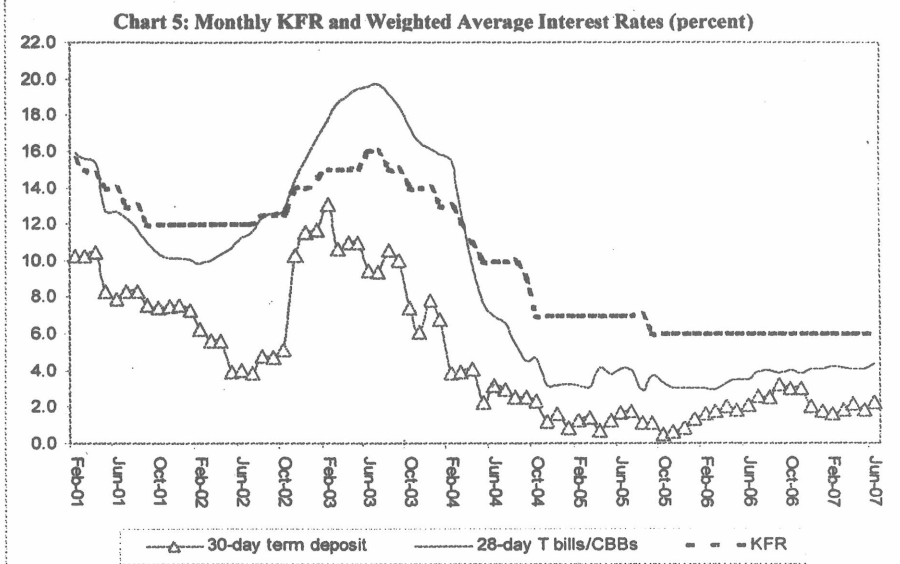
The kina appreciated against the US dollar, while depreciating against the Australian dollar during the seven months to July 2007. It appreciated against the US dollar from US\$0.3300 at the end of December 2006 to US\$0.3400 on 26th July 2007. The kina depreciated against the Australian dollar from A\$0.4171 to A\$0.3844 during the same period. The TWI depreciated by 3.1 percent over the same period, whilst the REER depreciated by 1.5 percent to March 2007, indicating an improvement in the terms of trade of PNG's exports (see Chart 3).

The appreciation of the kina against the US dollar was due to Central Bank intervention to stabilise the kina in view of the depreciation against the Australian dollar combined with foreign exchange inflows from the mineral and agriculture sectors. The depreciation against the Australian dollar was due to cross currency movements attributed to interest rate differentials and the slow down in the US economy. In the second half of 2007, the kina is expected to remain stable particularly against the US dollar on the back of continued favourable performance in the external sector and stable domestic economic conditions.

2.7 Monetary and Financial Market Developments

The Bank maintained a neutral monetary policy stance during the first half of 2007, with the KFR remaining unchanged at 6.0 percent (see Chart 5). The trading margin for the Repo was left unchanged at 150 basis points on both sides of the KFR during the same period.

Interest rates for short-term securities continued to remain relatively stable in the first six months of 2007, with the 28-day CBB rate at around 4.00 percent. In the Treasury bill market, the 182-day and 364-day Treasury bill rates traded in the range of 4.06 - 5.01 percent.



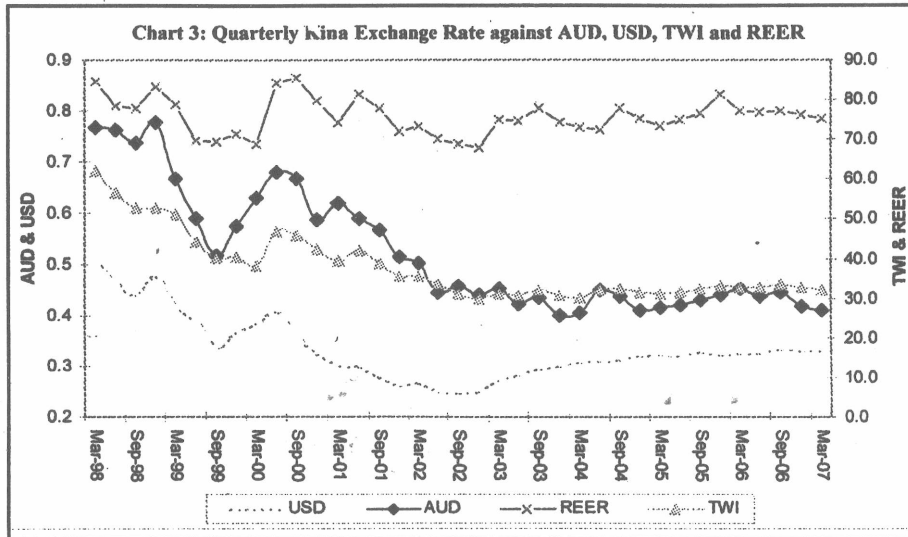

Commercial banks reduced their Indicator Lending Rates (ILR) spread from 9.45 - 10.70 percent to 8.95 - 10.70 percent during the first half of 2007. The ILR reductions reflect the high level of liquidity in the banking system and increased competition. The weighted average interest rate on total deposits declined from 1.04 percent in December 2006 to 0.92 percent in June 2007, while the weighted average lending rate on total loans declined from 10.20 percent to 10.18 percent. As a result, the spread between the weighted average lending and deposit rates remained relatively stable (see Chart 6).

Total liquidity of the banking system declined marginally by 0.1 percent between January and June 2007, mainly due to net Government revenue and intervention in the foreign exchange market by the Central Bank. However, liquidity levels remained high, averaging at K3,775 million during the same period.

Lending extended by ODCs to the private sector increased by 35.2 percent over the year to June 2007. The growth in private sector credit was mainly to the retail, agriculture/fisheries/forestry, mining and quarrying, and other business sectors. Net claims on the Government declined by 36.6 percent over the year to June 2007, mainly due to increased deposits and the maturing of Government securities held by ODCs.

The level of broad money supply (M3*) increased by 35.1 percent over the year to June 2007 as a result of growth in net foreign assets and increase in private sector credit. The monetary base increased by 12.9 percent during the same period (see Appendix).

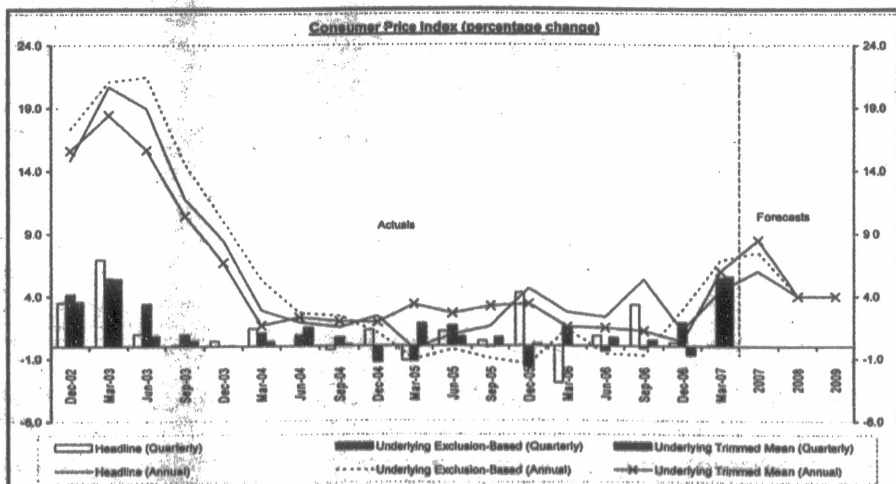

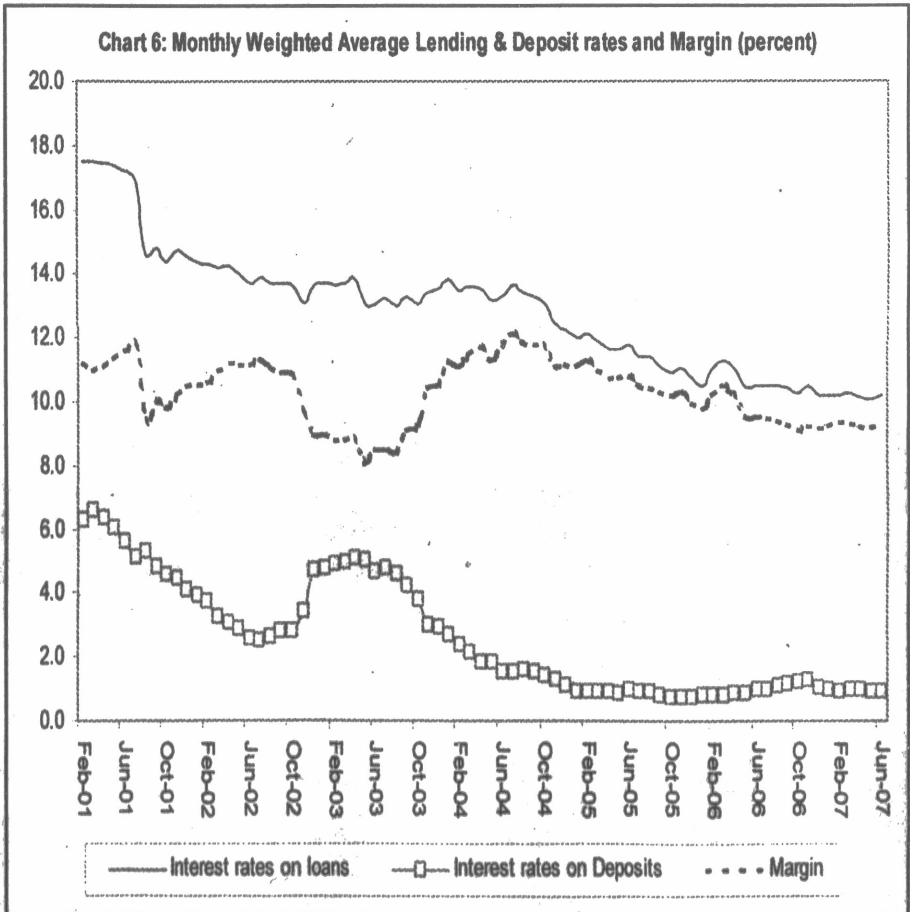
2.6 Inflation

Annual headline inflation was 4.5 percent in March 2007, compared to 1.3 percent in December 2006. The higher outcome was due to price increases in the 'Food', 'Clothing and footwear', 'Rents, council charges, fuel and power', and 'Transport and communications' expenditure groups. Annual trimmed mean inflation was 6.0 percent in March 2007, compared to 0.4 percent in December 2006 while annual exclusion based inflation was 6.9 percent in March 2007 compared to 1.9 percent in December 2006. The higher than projected inflation outcomes were mainly due to the depreciation in the TWI, imported inflation from PNG's main trading partners and the lagged effect of fuel price increases.

In 2007, headline inflation is projected to be 6.0 to 8.0 percent. The higher inflation forecasts are due to the depreciation of the TWI and higher foreign inflation in PNG's main trading partners. For the medium-term, all inflation measures are projected to be around 4.0 percent (see Chart 4 and Appendix). The medium-term projections are based on the assumptions that the kina exchange rate and commodity and energy prices remain stable. The main risks to these forecasts include adverse movements in the kina exchange rate, especially against the Australian dollar, significant declines in export prices and further increases in monetary aggregates.

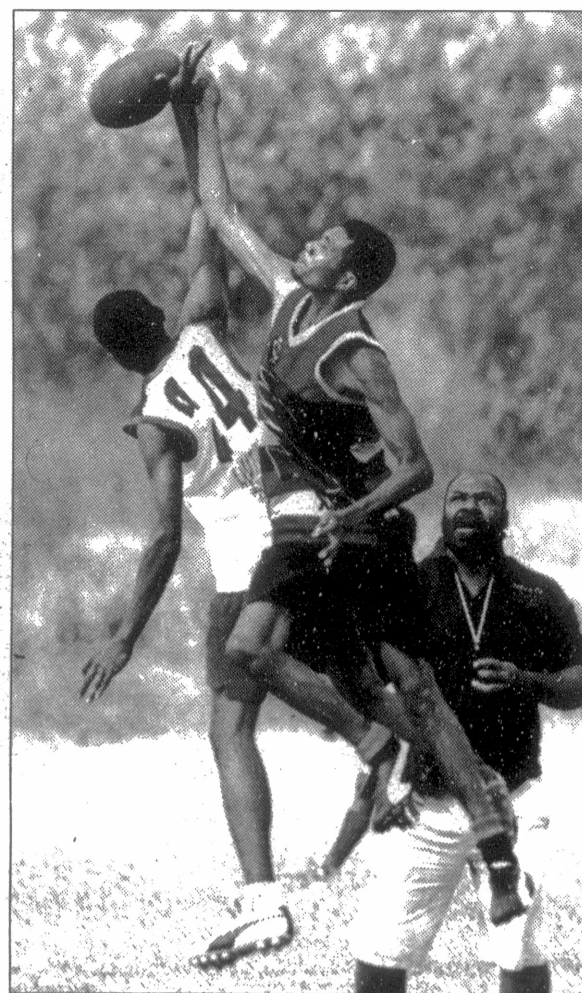

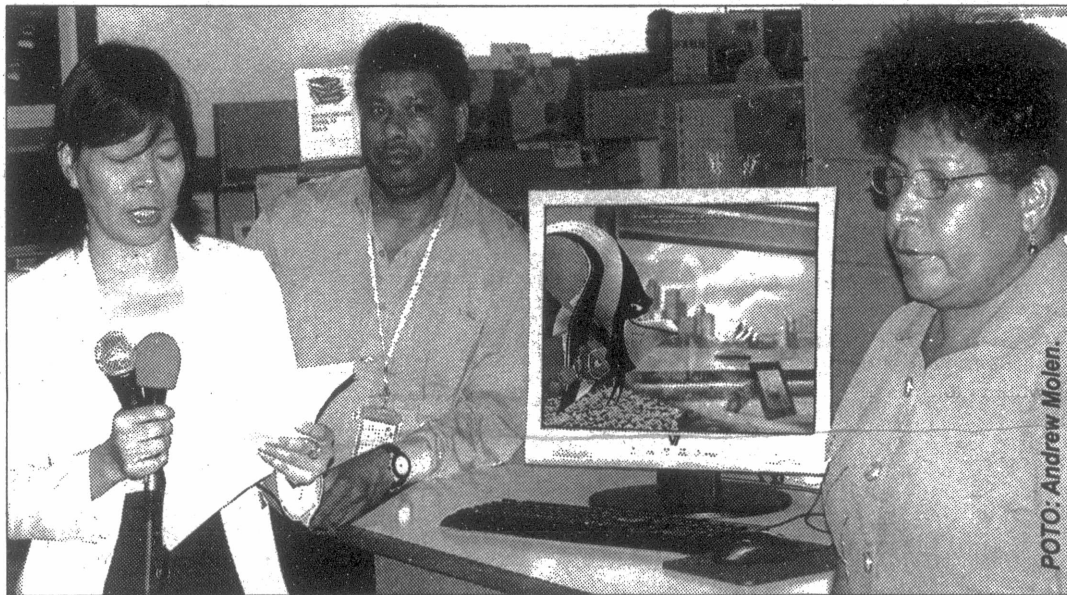

Elections Successful

Papua New Guinea will have a new Government after the successful national elections, which has just ended.

Constitutionally, its formation will be determined by the highest number of winning candidates scored by a political party in the election race.

When the writs for the 109 seats of the National Parliament are returned on or after the 30th July 2007, the Electoral Commissioner is empowered to recommend to the Governor-General, the political party with the most winning candidates to form the next Government.

Early figures from declarations indicated the ruling National Alliance Party headed by Grand Chief Sir Michael Somare topped the tally of the number of candidates winning seats in all the regions of the country.

Many of the candidates who ran as independents have also scored victories while other registered political parties scored wins but their numbers were yet to be confirmed.

Early election results showed that Party leaders who retained their seats included, People National Congress's, Peter O'Niell, Melanesian Liberal Party's, Dr Allan Marat, Rural Development Party's, Moses Maladina, Country Party's, Jamie Maxtone Graham, People's Progress Party's, Byron Chan, Sir Mekere Morauta of the PNG Party and Bart Philemon of the New Generation Party.

National Alliance Leader and Prime Minister, Sir Michael Somare was comfortably leading in the East Sepik Regional seat, while, PDM leader, Paias Wingti was also leading the tally for the Western Highlands Regional seat, the leader of the People's Party, Peter Ipatas was in a commanding leader for the Enga Regional seat.

Meanwhile, the Electoral Commissioner, Mr Andrew Trawen, the Police Commissioner, Mr Gari Baki and the Registrar of Political Parties, Mr Paul Bengo have expressed satisfaction at the overall good conduct of the elections.

During a recent press conference, they said though, there were sporadic problems during the campaigning, polling and counting

periods, the overall conduct of the election was dubbed as a success.

They attributed the success to the determination and commitment of security personnel, election managers, returning officers, assistant returning officers and provincial election steering committees.

Electoral Commissioner, Mr. Trawen said: "I expected counting

and declarations to be finished in all electorates, and the writs to be returned for the 2007 General Elections by the target date of 30 July 2007".

He said he was aware a number of provinces were under a lot of pressure to the 30 July deadline but he had requested his staff to assist to complete the elections on time.

"I commend the Police

Commissioner, Commander of the Defence Force and Commissioner of Correctional Services for a job well done.

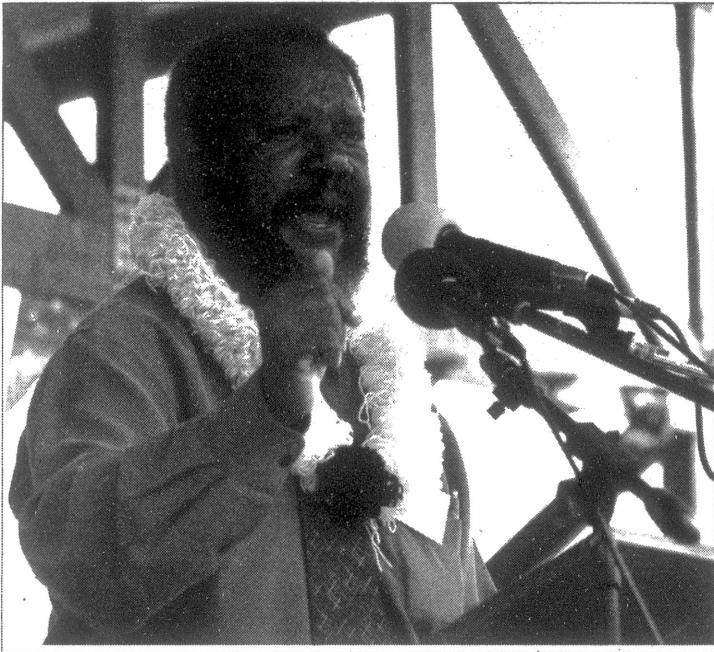

Minister Calls For Agriculture Development

Minister for Agriculture and Livestock, Hon. Sasa Zibe has challenged the people of Central Province to make customary land available for agriculture development. He said development projects such as the Mekeo Hinterland agro-forest and integrated oil palm and Jetropha project will create further

investment opportunities.

The Minister made these remarks in a speech delivered on his behalf during the ground-breaking ceremony of the Mekeo Hinterland Oil Palm and Jetropha Project in Imounga village in the Kairuku District of the Central Province.

He said the launching of the multi-million investment project in Imounga has been initiated under the Tree and Industrial Crops Development Priority of the National Agriculture Development Plan.

Mr Zibe encouraged the landowners, developers and the Government to continue working together for the success of this economic investment project.

The Minister also called for further strengthening of linkage with other commodity agencies and stakeholder partners to develop meaningful agriculture in the Central Province.

He said public and private sector investment in the agriculture is poor and stagnant and is performing at a sluggish pace.

"The government's economic policies and public investments

in the past two decades have been biased towards the development of non-renewable resources sector concentrating on mining and petroleum at the expense of the agriculture, forestry and fisheries," he said.

He said due to low investment and poor financial support, poverty is still wide spread in PNG, especially in rural areas and squatter settlements in the urban centres.

"Poverty is and will continue to be the biggest obstacle to sustainable socio-economic security in the country.

"Food shortages are now common in areas with high population densities and land pressure and areas prone to unusual climate conditions and natural calamities such as drought, floods, cyclone and volcanic episodes", the Minister said.

He said his Department would ensure all farmers are resourced with high yielding planting materials, resistant to pest to have continuous access to improve socio-economic conditions through sustainable agriculture farming

systems to enhance income-earning opportunities.

Mr. Zibe said the current government has made substantial investment to the agriculture sector and that is oriented towards economic development targeting rural areas.

"Investment in broad-base sustainable commercial agriculture using nucleus estate and out-grower development models is an appropriate option as it offers opportunities for employment and income base for the rural people," the Minister said.

The Department has undertaken a number of policy initiatives such as PNG National Food Security 2000-2010 and the PNG Rice Development Policy, 2004-2014 to address poverty and food insecurity.

He said it had recently finalised the formulation of the National Agriculture Development Plan.

The plan is a significant government initiative and a step in the right direction to attract investment to the agriculture sector. ■

Mr. Ambia said: "Foresters nowadays look at the easy way out, usually looking for excuses to back out from inventory work because they prefer to drive around in their vehicles rather than go to the bush.

"Nevertheless, it is not easy, someone has to do it, and you have volunteered to carry out this very important task."

The national forest inventory is one of three basic tools that completes the National Forest Plan.

He said it was important that the national forest inventory be carried out because without the knowledge of resources, it is impossible to know the species or volumes.

"Although remote sensing can be used, this may be successful for plantation species only and not for natural growths, where there are different species growing together.

So, the best way to collect data in PNG would be for foresters to physically go into the jungle to collect data," Mr Ambia.

Data collected during the ongoing inventory work will be used for the National Forest Inventory Programme.

Mr. Ambia did two presentations in relation to the relevance of the forest inventory in forest management, and linking forest inventory to mapping. NFS Supervisor Inventory, Ledino Saega presented a paper on height measurements which is often a main source of error in forest inventories.

Officers also had the opportunity to visit the Mapping Bureau to appreciate the forest type maps that

were based on Forest Inventory Mapping (FIM) database.

Other issues raised at the Workshop included the need for refresher courses on tree identification, different forms of certification of consultants especially those involved in forest inventory, proper technical procedures to be followed during inventories, training of officers in the use of Global Positioning Systems (GPS), equipping area officers with GPS for inventory other mapping work, and the engagement of new cadet foresters in future surveys. ■

Foreign Affairs and Trade Minister, Hon. Paul Tiensten says Papua New Guinea's membership to the Asia Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC) is very important for its trade, economic growth and social development.

He said the Asia-Pacific remains the fastest growing and dynamic regions in the world and PNG's membership is a step forward for the benefit of its people.

Minister Tiensten said PNG, as a member would benefit from APEC in areas such as the multilateral trading system under the World Trade Organization for global economic growth and development.

He said this at the VIP Lounge at the Jackson's International Airport in Port Moresby on 7th July 2007

upon arrival from the meeting of APEC Ministers responsible for Trade in Cairns, Australia, held from July 5-6, 2007.

He told journalists that broad-ranging and constructive discussions about ways and means to promote regional economic integration were held at the meeting.

"We discussed various ways to achieve free trade in the region including the possibility of developing a Free Trade Area of the Asia-Pacific (FTAAP) as a long term prospect.

"In this regard, we reaffirmed our commitment to the Bogor Goals, agreeing that the time is right to further examine the prospect for an FTAAP including its implications," Minister Tiensten told the reporters.

He said Regional Trade Agreement/Free Trade Agreements could advance economic openness in the region and strengthen regional economic integration.

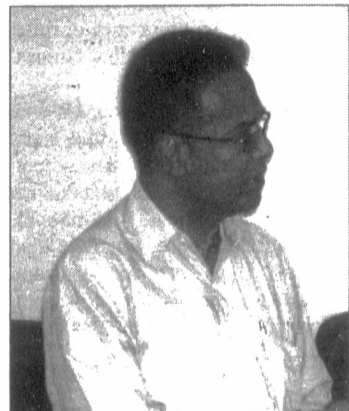
And he said they can also serve as building blocks for further development of the multilateral trading system and can bring the realisation of the Bogor Goals nearer.

Minister Tiensten confirmed the endorsement APEC's second Trade Facilitation Action Plan, which sets out a framework for achieving the goal of another 5% reduction in trade transaction costs by 2010.

He said APEC's current facilitation work on customs, standards, procedures conformance, e-commerce and mobility of business people is already providing substantial benefits to PNG.

Minister Tiensten who was accompanied by Mr. Elias Wohengu Director General of Economic and Development Co-operation of the Department said these results reinforce the important role of trade facilitation in the region and APEC's reform agenda. ■

Momis Commissioned As New Envoy To China

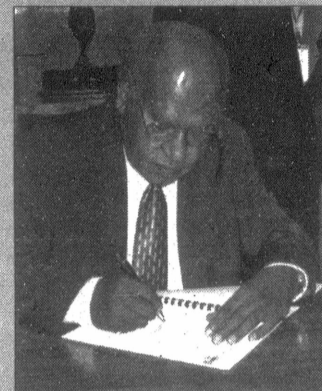

Property Rights Seminar To Be Hosted In The Capital

Papua New Guinea will be hosting the Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC) regional seminar on Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) Enforcement, from August 28-29, 2007.

The Seminar will focus on IPR enforcement related issues affecting the Asia-Pacific region, and share information and experience on how to deal with Intellectual Property (IP) infringements.

The Seminar will also discuss issues on piracy and counterfeiting of goods which are believed to be on the rise in the region.

According to the IPR organising committee, these problems are common in PNG, and are affecting the economy in terms of loss of tax revenue to the Government.

It was also noted that companies and individuals involved in the illegal activities of the production, distribution and sale of counterfeit and pirated goods, avoid paying taxes to the authorities.

The Committee says some counterfeit goods are consumable items may pose health risks to

consumers.

"Some of the pharmaceutical drugs and condoms being sold in the country are also counterfeits," it stated.

It is expected that Papua New Guinea can learn from other APEC member economies experiences in dealing with such cases, through the establishment of an effective IPR enforcement system.

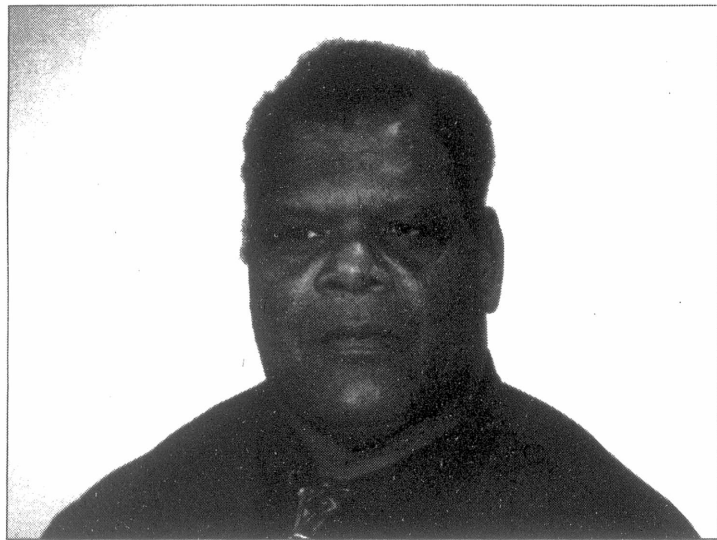
"The aim is to establish effective IPR enforcement mechanisms that would compliment the current cross border measures by the Internal Revenue Commission and the Intellectual Property registry administered by the Intellectual Property Office.

Thirteen APEC member economies have been invited to participate in the seminar, with further twenty-eight participants from the Pacific Island Forum member countries.

Some eminent international speakers on IPR enforcement from Australia, Mexico, Philippines, Thailand, Japan and the United States have also been invited to address the seminar. ■

Return To Teaching Service: Pearson Urges

Chairman of the Teaching Service Commission, Mr Michael Pearson has called on teachers who have contested the 2007 elections to return to the teaching service.

Mr Pearson said teachers who have exercised their constitutional right to contest elections as permitted under Teaching Service Act, should seek re-admission to the teaching service.

This, he said has to be done within two months of the declaration of results for the respective electorates.

All requests for re-admission must be sent to; Chairman, Teaching Service Commission, P.O. Box 6268, Boroko 111, National Capital District.

Requests can also be faxed to the Chairman, Teaching Service Commission office at Waigani on fax number 301 3314 or can be delivered to the Chairman, Teaching

Service Commission, 7th Floor, Fincorp Haus, Independence Drive, Waigani, NCD.

"A copy must also be sent to the Provincial Education Advisor's Office so that the teacher can be returned to the teacher's tenure position

"They can be placed on other suitable positions if the teacher has no right of tenure or if the tenure position has been abolished," he said.

Mr Pearson said failure to request re-admission within two months as required will result in the teachers not being permitted to return to the teaching service.

He also highlighted that teachers who did not resign from the teaching service but contested elections will be terminated under the Teaching Service Act, effective from the issue of writs.

He added that teachers who resigned under Section 122 or any other sections other than section 12, after the invoking of section 124 and

while section 124 is in operation, are prevented by section 124 from returning to the teaching service.

Mr Pearson said teachers who resigned under the Teaching Service Act, Section 124 but have not complied with the requirements of section 124 will not be re-admitted to the teaching service.

He said this includes those who resigned after November 4, 2006.

Mr Pearson strongly warned teachers who breached the laws relating to elections or other laws will be deregistered as teachers.

"Teachers who are not re-admitted to the teaching service as a result of failing to meet with the requirements of Section 124 of the Teaching Service Act but are still registered teachers under the Education Act can be private tutors of students and charge fees for this service.

They can also seek employment with other Education providers in permitted schools," said Mr Pearson.

Teachers who require further information or advice on the possible readmission or non readmission and payment of entitlements should contact; Inspector Appointments on phone 301 3307 or Commissioner Operations on phone 301 3305.

Meanwhile, the Teaching Service Commission has placed a ban on the engagement of new teachers into the teaching service after July 10, 2007 that is Term 3 and 4 to fill vacant positions.

Mr Pearson said the only exception is teachers who wish to return after their resignation for election purposes under Section 124 of the Teaching Service Act.

"These teachers should apply for reinstatement before their two months grace period expires. The grace period he said starts from the date of declaration of election results in the respective electorates." ■

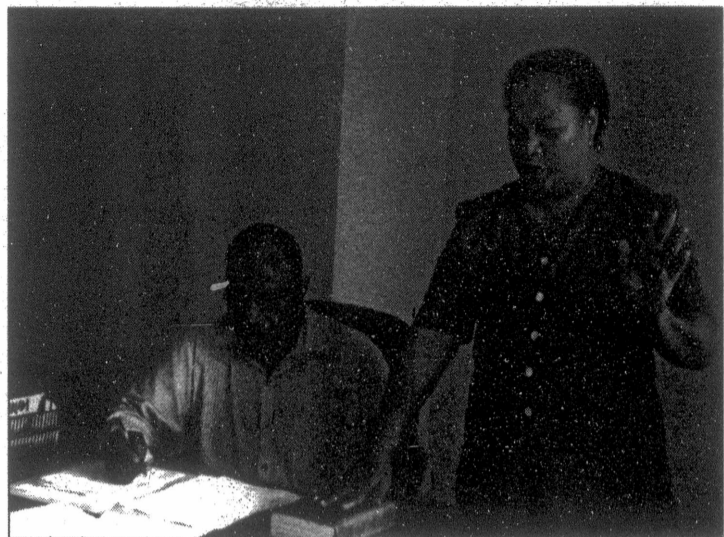

The Office of Rural Development administers public funds channeled through members of parliament for various development projects in the 89 districts throughout Papua New Guinea.

It also ensures that these funds are properly spend and acquitted. ■

Public Servants Urge To Focus On Service Delivery

Acting Director of the Office Of Rural Development, Mr. Paul Sai has called on all public servants to focus on service delivery.

He told members of his staff during the swearing-in ceremony this month that public service delivery is about bringing development to the bulk of the population.

"Public servants and those who join the public service need to constantly remind themselves that they are servants of the people and need to focus their duties around service delivery to the entire population of PNG.

"Our people are the target of public service delivery; and that should be the guiding message as we perform our duties," he said.

"The road will help the man sell his cash crops to earn money and improve his lifestyle and that is the impact and intervention touching the lives of many Papua New Guineans," Mr. Sai said.

He was speaking during the swearing into office of two new employees who joined the Office of Rural Development.

The Officers are; Kaia Nou, the Executive Secretary and Meggy Kepa, Personnel Officer. ■

New Water Supply For Bali Islanders

Bali Islanders in West New Britain now have adequate water supply.

This has been made possible with funding of a rural water supply project by the Office of Rural Development through the member for Talasea, Hon. John Vulupindi.

ORD facilitated the project with a K400,000 funding support from the member's District Support Improvement Program.

The project was approved by the Joint District Planning (JDP) & Budget Priority Committee of the Talasia District and facilitated by ORD and approve by the National Supplies and Tenders Board.

Eight villages are connected to some form of proper water supply from different water sources. And recently water started running from taps, ending years of labor by the population in fetching water from distant water wells and up hill streams.

Some villages are enjoying full

supply while improvement on gravity feed to others is required to push more water to low-lying villages to receive water.

Bali Island is mountainous and blessed with so many streams that had made it easier for the down stream supply.

Mr. Vulupindi said the water supply was the best gift to his people and to an island he left 45 years ago to serve the nation as a public servant, rising to finance secretary and later member for Talasia for two consecutive terms.

He said his side of the Island is yet to receive water and he expected that to happen in the second phase.

He attributed the success of the introduction of the water supply to the combined efforts of all the stakeholders, including the JDP & BPC, ORD, the Technical Services division in Kimbe, consultants, contractors and the National Supplies and Tenders Board for installing a vital service to his people. ■

Promise Fulfilled: Prime Minister Somare

The Somare-led Government has fulfilled its promise of starting a new bank for the people of Papua New Guinea.

And Papua New Guineans will now have access to what is now called: 'The National Development Bank' - previously known as the Rural Development Bank.

Prime Minister, Grand Chief, Sir Michael Somare officially launched the new bank in Madang

last month.

Sir Michael said; "The National Development Bank is a bank that understands our financial needs and is prepared to trust our ordinary people, companies and cooperatives.

"This bank is innovative and can develop tailor-made products and services to meet the needs of all our people in the highlands, low lands, coastal villages as well as urban informal sector communities," he said.

Sir Michael thanked his Cabinet and Parliament for passing the new National Development Bank Act 2007, which now removes all political influence in the management of the bank.

"This will no longer be the case because the new Act provides for the appointment of an independent Board and Management, which will operate without fear or favour," he said.

At the launching, Prime Minister Somare announced that the

National Development Bank would start its operations by taking over the current operations of the Rural Development Bank, with net assets valued at K45 million.

To mark the launching, Sir Michael presented an initial K3 million through the Bank, to the Madang Province based farmers and fishermen.

Sir Michael also announced that in addition to the assets being transferred to the NDB, his Government is capitalizing the

new Bank with an initial capital injection of K100 million this year.

He said K50 million will be provided by the shareholder, IPBC, while a further K50 million would come from the K100 million budgeted under the National Agricultural Development Plan.

He said, in this way the bank will be able to finance high impact agriculture projects that are bankable under the implementation of the Agriculture Development Plan. ■

Launching Timely: Lamur

Chairman of the National Development Bank (NDB), Mr. William Lamur has commended the Government for the timely establishment of the new Bank.

After a complete rehabilitation of the former Rural Development Bank, three years of tireless efforts resulted in the passing of the NDB Act 2007 on April 25th, 2007.

Mr Lamur said; "Madang Province is an example of how provinces can

benefit from partnerships with the new bank.

"We will sign new MOA's for credit schemes for commercial fishing and commercial chicken farming that have been initiated with the Government's support and private sector partners, RD Tuna Cannery Limited and Bangui Bio Products Limited," he said.

He said the Board and Management would transfer all their assets and liabilities to the new NDB with much experience, a very strong management team and a group of hard working staff.

The new management plans to refurbish all sixteen branches and that will cost upwards of K10 million which is needed to enter the commercial microfinance business and upwards of K100 million to develop both the agriculture, commercial and fishing loan books to make the bank viable.

"The new Bank is a sleeping giant because we have the branch network, the skills and experience of over 40 years but most importantly, it has the loyalty and support of our people as our bank," said Mr. Lamur. ■

Gov't Signs Pact With New Bank

The Government has signed two MOAs with the National Development Bank.

The first has been signed with the Madang Provincial Government, the Bank and Bangui Limited for the establishment and roll out of the Madang Village Chicken Credit Scheme.

Prime Minister, Grand Chief, Sir Michael Somare said; "Under this scheme, the Government will provide long-term loans for village chicken farmers to borrow up to K30,000 from the Bank to build chicken sheds and supplies like stock feed to produce and sell chickens to the new chicken processing plant funded by NDB at Matukar, outside Madang.

The other MOA was signed between the Madang Provincial Government, National Development Bank, and RD Tuna Cannery Limited for the Madang Fisheries Credit Scheme under the Fisheries Credit Facility.

"An initial seed funding of K1 million will be made available for the establishment of the scheme.

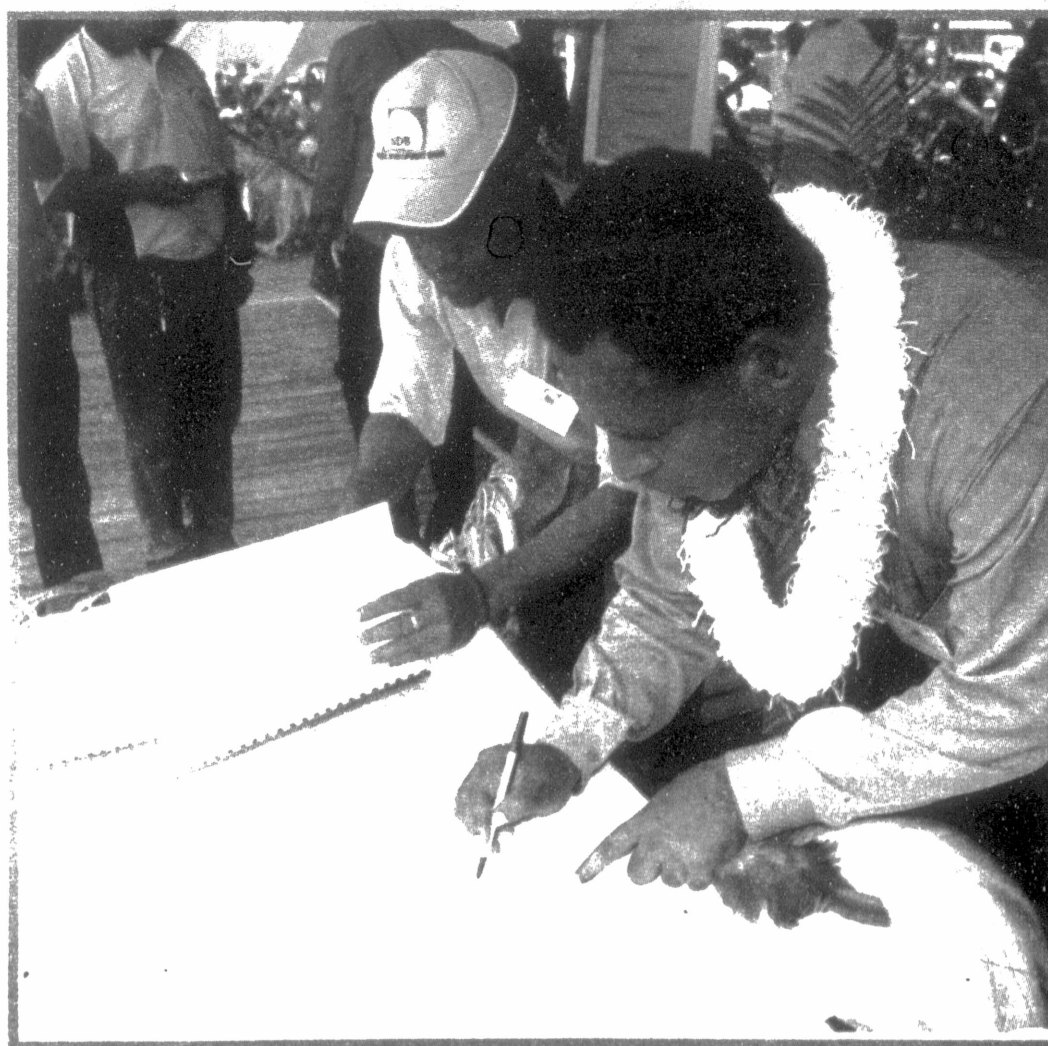
Under this scheme, each fishing group can borrow up to K50,000 from the Bank for pump boats and establish commercial fishing businesses. They will sell the fish to RD Tuna Cannery Limited," said Sir Michael.

The new bank will venture into village housing loans, rural electricity loans under the solar power roll-out and micro-finance mini loans from K1,000 upwards for people mobilised under self-help groups.

He said; "In order to undertake its new and widened scope of operations to better serve our people, the Bank must be adequately resourced to carry out its functions.

"My Government has allocated K2 million for the Bank to build and implement a new management information system which is already effective and has the ability to provide electronic identification cards for customers."

He added that this would enable the Bank to provide simple bank accounts for the ordinary village people who do not read and write and cannot sign their names. ■

Expect More Financial Services From The Bank

The National Development Bank, under the new Act, now has the legal powers to provide a wide range of financial services.

Prime Minister, Grand Chief, Sir Michael Somare said the Bank will be able to mobilize savings by offering savings accounts and interest bearing deposits, provided it applies for and secures a license from the Bank of Papua New Guinea to offer these services.

Sir Michael said; "The National Development Bank can also offer other financial services such as

insurance products.

"It is my Government's vision that the National Development Bank will not only provide loans to village people, companies and co-operatives but it will also offer passbooks and savings accounts from next year, 2008 under a micro-bank roll-out similar to the Wau Micro-bank."

Apart from financial services, the bank will also offer new and innovative loan products like the village commercial fisheries loans which was launched under the Fisheries Credit Facility early this year. ■

Correctional Services Re-aligns Role

THE PNG Correctional Service (CS) has re-aligned its role as a responsive force and a more focused force in the country.

Alluding to its strategic Corporate Plan and availing itself to other national tasks, the CS' recent engagement in the 2007 general elections has reinforced this focus.

Operations Officer and veteran CS commander Chief Inspector Michael Waipo is among those at the helm of the planning, insertion and working closely with both the Police and Defence Force officers.

"It is a new alliance with the security forces. This exercise has really boosted our assessment, both as a responsive force and as a key member of the disciplined forces," said Mr Waipo.

He further added that the selected personnel are now mobile, realigned and more aware of preventative security measures, crowd control and networking with the populace.

Despite, momentary deviating from its mandated task as prison officers, those selected have, in the commander's assessment benefited from the new role.

"As a discipline force, the CS officers are now more receptive, prepared and above all are better informed. They are also keen to participate and will also be looked on if needed in further operations," said Mr Waipo.

Their deployment in the Kagua-Grave, Mendi, Okapa and Karamui-Nomane electorates has been a significant boost to the security forces presence.

"It is a great assistance for us," says Assistant Commissioner Joab Mangae of the Police Headquarters.

"Their presence has allowed us to

concentrate on risky areas, and their rapport with the local populace, has facilitated for good and fairer elections."

ACP Mangae, who is overseeing elections in both the Eastern Highlands and Simbu provinces, commended the professionalism, the conduct and the tokenism portrayed in the exercise.

His colleague from the Police Commissioner's office, Chief Superintendent Awan Sete commended the CS with admiration.

"Their insertions has been in some of the most remote and difficult areas. Yet, despite, delays in transport and logistical needs, they have demonstrated true grit.

"They were just ready to move on to the next area of operation, despite this and their morale is always high," said Mr Sete.

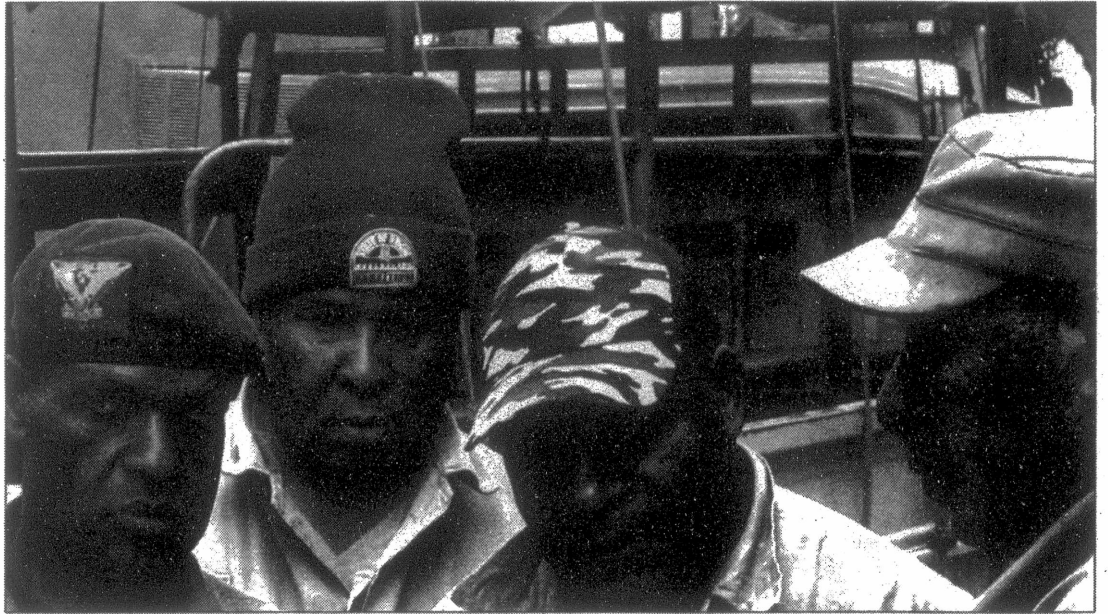
The observations by the two senior officers is telling of a disciplined, energetic and cohesive force, something the CS top hierarchy has been prompted to blend with its Corporate Plan, launched last year.

CS Commissioner, Mr. Richard Sikani's forte in revamping the force into a multi-skilled force has begun that sensuous, and calibrated path.

Already, his commanders are alluding to his call, that the prison service needs to lift its fiduciary role inline with the changing trends of the country's development.

The engagement has also had some successes and told by the warders themselves, with great enthusiasm.

Senior Inspector David Suago says the presence of CS personnel in some of the electorates has given some hope to voters. Mr Suago said, since their deployment, warders

have used the occasion to conduct awareness and reemphasise the need for fairer and transparent elections.

"The presence of CS officers was welcomed very well. People came and were keen to assist. My officers have carried out their responsibilities very well and we faced fewer problems," said Mr Suago.

That response, he believes is attributed to the sense of preparedness and commitment of his officers. Moreover, previous experiences with the police force prompted the constituents to respond to the warders with renewed optimism.

"The men were exposed to danger, and even dispute resolution in the course of this exercise. They were able to deal with some of the issues in a non-confrontational way, something, the community is not

used to" said Mr Suago.

These kinds of developments, says Suago, are necessary to improve and open up the broad role of the security personnel. He believes the exposure has propelled the warders a few paces ahead of their routine roles, a leap, and his officers are keen to extend.

Warder Ruben Waffi from the Kerevat jail in the East New Britain Province was among the first to applaud the call out.

Waffi was ecstatic at the sight of people welcoming the CS entourage that visited the Upper Mendi villages. As part of the CS advance team, the exercise brought "to fruition the CS overall engagement strategy of strengthening relations to create a conducive environment for the voters.

"We were received with open arms as men, women, children

and elderly spoke to us about our approach. We listened to them, as they expressed what they believe a shift from previous exposures with our security personnel," said Mr Waffi.

The climax was the slaughtering of a pig and a feast prepared for the CS warders, some of whom had not been to the Highlands before.

Commander Waipo added that this reconnaissance was necessary to prepare the officers which blended fittingly with their combat tactics training.

"It has helped the men and paid off handsomely. This is the kind of force, the Commissioner is adamant on building. I am sure, many of the individuals who participated in this exercise are now well prepared, should the CS be called upon in the future," said Mr Waipo. ■

Justice Sector Launches Success Book

The law and justice sector has reached another milestone in disseminating information to agencies and communities in the country.

And its recently launched book called; 'Success Stories 2006' tells the people of PNG the challenges faced by the sector.

Director, Mr. Kepas Paon says

Mr Paon said the book is for technical students and will be distributed to schools when copies

are made available not only in NCD but throughout the country.

However, Chairman and Secretary of Department of National Planning and Monitoring, Mr. Valentine Kambori said the launch of the book is an easy show and turn around for the sector.

He said this is how the Government's Medium Term Development Strategy has been stipulated and aligned.

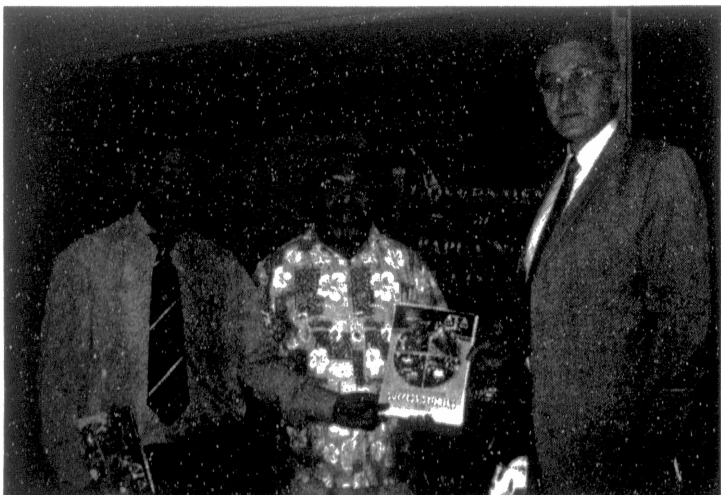
"Sectors like the law and justice, transport and health are doing well in their overall performance and this must be told through this book," he said.

Sir Peter Launches Health Care Program

A community and home-based care program, aimed at delivering care services to families living with HIV/AIDS, at the community level, was officially launched this month, by the Minister for Health Sir Peter Barter.

The program is among seven others that are being initiated by the Family Health International in PNG to combat HIV/AIDS.

When launching the program, Sir Peter, paid tribute to international non-government organizations, such as FHI, the United States and Australia for their continued partnership in combating HIV/AIDS in the country.

He said, as more people in the country unite to combat the HIV epidemic, the twin priorities will remain preventing HIV infection, and care for those infected, and those whose households and families have to cope with the infection.

Sir Peter urged people living with HIV to be part of the planning, the implementation, delivery, monitoring and evaluation of care and treatment.

He also appealed to health staff to bring clinical care to AIDS patients in their own homes, so as to ease pressure on hospitals and health centers, and to reach those who never come for treatment.

"Clinical care is not enough. Patients and their families need counseling to help them to come to terms with AIDS, the fear of death, and anxieties about their children's

future.

"Family Health International offers the prospect of health professionals working with community volunteers. These community volunteers must have training in basic health care, AIDS education and counseling, including the knowledge of good nutrition, how to avoid opportunistic infections, and how to support families and households struggling with sickness and poverty," Sir Peter said.

He also called on the Department of Health to review training programs for health workers and decision-making within the health sector.

"Only then can we ensure that health staff have the knowledge, the commitment and resources for reaching out to build partnerships with community carers," Sir Peter added.

Country Director for FHI/PNG, Mrs Nayer Kaviani, said twenty-three sites in the Central Province and National Capital District have been identified for the program.

These sites will be opened for counseling, testing, services relating to sexually transmitted infections, encouraging safe sex and access to treatment.

Other educational information and communications booklets and pamphlets on HIV/AIDS were also launched, while twenty-five health workers and community team leaders graduated with certificates.

Community leader of Babaka, Tetagana Rupa, commended FHI/PNG, for such an initiative, saying

it would reduce the problem of transportation, shortage of medical officers and the long waiting time at the urban clinics.

FHI/PNG in partnership with the Friends Foundation Inc., HOPE World Wide (PNG), the National Spiritual Assembly of the Baha's in PNG, National AIDS Council Secretariat, PNG Institute of Medical Research, Department of Health, PNG Red Cross Society, Salvation Army and Save the Children in PNG, in ensuring that

the programs are effectively carried out, in providing training on home-based care for people living with AIDS, their families, and health care workers.

Twenty-five health care workers, social workers and community team leaders underwent the two-week training to provide quality care.

Babaka village in the Central Province is among the twenty-three sites, while urban clinics around NCD, are also being selected for

the project.

The US Agency for International Development and the Australian Agency for International Development are major donors of the program.

The other FHI initiated projects are; Helvim Bilong Yumi (Our Help), Lukautim Laif - Noho Namo (Protect Your Life - Live well), Mauri Namona Oi Maurilaia (You Live a Good Life), Poro Sapot, Sirus Naraq and Tingim Laip. ■

US To Increase Its Health Funding

DNPM Launches Corporate Plan

The Department of National Planning and Monitoring recently launched its Corporate Plan at Port Moresby.

Minister for Finance and Planning, Hon. John Hickey says the Department is the mandated agency for development planning and as such, must clearly articulate its corporate and strategic responsibilities to ensure that development strategies are implemented through a responsive

and planned Public Investment Program.

"The central agency department responsible for charting PNG's development path, must take the lead in clearly articulating its plan to deliver on its responsibilities and functions. Only then will the Department have a clear blue print for the discharge of its core business.

"The Corporate Plan is the instrument through which the delivery of the MTDS will be facilitated," Mr. Hickey said.

In introducing the Corporate Plan, Secretary for the Department, Mr. Valentine Kambori said as a central agency, the Department needed to reflect high standards of corporate values and ethics in fulfilling its tasks.

"Given the wide ranging nature of the mandated responsibilities of DNPM, from formulation of national development strategy, to development programming and budgeting, monitoring and evaluation, donor coordination and mobilisation, coordination of provincial and district plans and programs; the clear articulation of that role into the Strategic and Corporate Plan has been a challenge," said Mr. Kambori.

However the challenge was overcome through a process of comprehensive analysis, and a process of consultation and consensus that ensured the wishes of all stakeholders, including staff of the Department were incorporated in the Plan.

"I am satisfied that the Strategic and Corporate Plan provides a clear blue print for the Department to deliver on its mandated roles and responsibilities to PNG.

"There is no doubt, the future viability of such a plan depends on a review process and the Corporate Plan provides for that to take place," Mr. Kambori added. ■

Forum To Assess Tuna Industry


A Pacific Tuna Forum for the industry executives and fleet operators in the region will be held in Port Moresby from September 12-13, 2007.

The conference will assess, among other things, the current tuna stocks and resources in the region, investment opportunities for fishing and processing, markets and marketing and international trade and trade barriers.

The forum is jointly organized

by INFOFISH, a service-oriented inter-governmental organization based in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, the National Fisheries Authority, Forum Fisheries Agency (FFA), the PNG Fishing Industry Association and other regional and international fisheries organisations.

It has been revealed that the Pacific ocean, in particular the Western and Central region, of which Papua New Guinea is a part, contributes more than 64 percent of the world tuna catch of around 4.2 million tonnes. ■



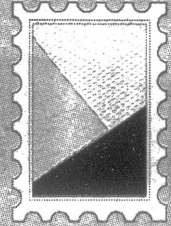

Labour Dept Improves Database

The Department of Labour and Industrial Relations is set to address unemployment among Papua New Guineans using a new information system.

This has been made possible with the recent launch of the Labour Market Information System (LMIS) to support employment creation and growth in Papua New Guinea.

Minister for Labour and Industrial Relations, Hon. Mathew Siune said there was neither a centralised database nor any organisation that stores or disseminates vital information on the country's labour market.

Mr. Siune said: "The Department of Labour and Industrial Relations is mandated to facilitate and promote labour oriented activities throughout the country. It does this through various mechanisms, including social security, industrial collaboration, social dialogue, human resource development.

"With this in mind, the department under the advice and guidance of the International Labour Organisation (ILO) has

initiated the development of the Labour Market Information System (LMIS)."

The information system will provide statistics on market trends and identify employment opportunities throughout PNG.

This will also assist with policy development and strategic planning activities.

Minister Siune outlined the following LMIS objectives:

- LMIS will allow the department to measure and assess

labour market capacity within PNG.

- The system will be a vital tool for developing programmes and policies to support employment creation throughout PNG.

- Externally, LMIS will play

an important role through the collection of meaningful statistics that can be used to assist employers and industry in understanding labour market needs.

- LMIS will provide insight to employment participation rates and skills shortages.

He said he was pleased that the statistics from the LMIS would assist PNG as it moves forward with the Development of key industry sectors.

The Department's Secretary, Mr. David Tibu said the funding of LMIS came through the Department of National Planning and Monitoring, under its development project funding.

"The LMIS information system is indeed Papua New Guinean's own home-grown and developed system," said Mr. Tibu.

He added that the project had been funded locally and the system development was also carried out by a local IT consultant.

Minister Siune said LMIS was a step forward for PNG and encouraged all citizens to work in partnership with the Department to broaden the scope and use of the new information system. ■
