

Media advisory on U.S. Student Pugwash Conference

California Governor Jerry Brown will address the closing plenary session of the week-long U.S. Student Pugwash Conference at the University of California, San Diego at 10 a.m. on Tuesday, June 26 in Liebow Auditorium in the Basic Science Building, School of Medicine.

The governor's topic of discussion will be "Arms Control and Disarmament."

Although seating is limited in Liebow Auditorium, the public and the media are invited to attend.

The Student Pugwash Conference, which began June 19, has brought together distinguished scientists and intellectual leaders from around the country to meet with 75 selected college and university students from various U.S. campuses to discuss the general topic of "Science and Ethical Responsibility."

Following his presentation, Gov. Brown will entertain guestions from the audience and will be available to meet with the media following the session.
