### Can We Talk?

Newsletter of the UCSD Medical Center GBL Network, published approximately monthly from March 1994 to Aug./Sept. 1995. Several master copies are in the personal papers collection of Patrick Dowd transferred to the LGHSSD, reproductions of which are included in appropriate Clippings sections of the Collection.

#### Common Ground.

As the Cross-Cultural Center newsletter and calendar, <u>Common Ground</u> has been regularly published under that name from Fall 1997 on a quarterly or bi-quarterly basis. Focusing on the broad gamut of diversity concerns, this newsletter has grown from being a calendar and publicity organ for the CCC to being a venue for dialogue on a variety of issues, including sexual orientation and gender issues, with articles written by students, staff, and faculty.

#### Critical Gender Studies Newsletter.

Published quarterly by the Critical Gender Studies Program (formerly the Women's Studies Program), which addresses gender and sexuality, including LGBT and Queer studies within an enlarged pedagogical framework of gender and related concerns. Copies of the newsletter are not in the Collection, but may be available from CGS. See "Other Sources of Historical Materials."

#### Diploma.

A San Diego area publication for graduate students, sponsored by the local chapter GAU from the late 1980's through early 1990's. Copies of the newsletter are not in the Collection, but are accessible as part of the permanent collections of the LGHSSD. See "Other Sources of Historical Materials."

#### UCSD Guardian.

Biweekly campus newspaper of UCSD, student published and written. The <u>UCSD Guardian</u> has become increasingly favorable in its coverage to LGBT-related news and feature stories since the mid-1990's. Extensive clippings from the mid-1990's on have been included in the archive on a range of LGBT-related issues and events.

#### GSUCSD Newsletter.

Between 1980 and 1983, the GSUCSD / LAGO published a full-page newsletter in the <u>UCSD Guardian</u> once a quarter, until <u>Sappho Speaks</u> began publication.

### LGBTA E-Newsletter.

Though not a print publication, a semi-monthly text newsletter was compiled and distributed via e-mail in 1998-99 by the LGBTA. It included announcements and LGBT/Queer news in digest format. A print out of each e-newsletter for 1998-99 has been included in a special Appendix section.

### New Indicator / Last Indicator.

An alternative newspaper published at UCSD and one of the oldest published periodical on campus, focused frequently on social issues. Politically, it has tended from progressive to radical, and has been one of the few venues for LGBT/Queer voice in campus media other than the <u>UCSD Guardian</u>. It has been published under various names for several decades. Since the early 1980's, the paper has been published as the <u>New Indicator</u> by the New Indicator Collective. In 1995, it changed its name from <u>New Indicator</u> to <u>Last Indicator</u>. In the 1990's it has been published by a student collective, the New Indicator Collective, and has received funding from the ASUCSD as an alternative media student organizatio. The New Indicator Collection also possesses extensive archives on alternative culture, politics, and student activism.

In Fall 1998, its archives were moved from the Student Center to a building adjacent to the Ché Café, and its not clear how accessible or well-preserved its archives have been since that time.

#### San Diego Union-Tribune.

Originally two separate daily newspapers, the <u>San Diego Union</u> and the <u>San Diego Tribune</u>, until merging in 1992. Published daily and distributed throughout San Diego County, the San Diego Union-Tribune is main newspaper in the region. It has published a number of articles on LGBT/Queer concerns at UCSD and community events in which students, faculty and staff have participated.

#### Sappho Speaks.

A quarterly periodical published between 1983-1986 by lesbian, gay and bisexual students at UCSD, and associated with LAGO. <u>Sappho Speaks</u> received funding from ASUCSD as an alternative media student organization. The LGBTA, Mandeville Special Collections Library, and the Lesbian & Gay Historical Society of San Diego, possess known copies of <u>Sappho Speaks</u>, copies of which have been reproduced for the Collection.

### UCSD Times.

The official campus news publication for staff and faculty at UCSD. Published monthly, and distributed on campus, the <u>UCSD Times</u> has announced several significant LGBT institutional events.

#### Under the Umbrella.

The Umbrella Group and its member organizations have produced an official newsletter since spring 1994. Published as the "Queer University Employees Newsletter," it became the "Umbrella Group Newsletter" after several issues. Since 1996, the Umbrella Group newsletter has been published with the name "Under the Umbrella." The UCSD Medical Center GBL Network sub-group also published "Can We Talk?" – see entry above.

#### Women's Center Calendar.

Produced and distributed quarterly, and more recently bi-quarterly, the Calendar has often included many events on sexual orientation and transgender issues, sponsored by the Women's Center, other campus units and affiliated organizations.
