

Mr. George Lichtheim, will lecture on "Ideas of the Future".

Mr. George Lichtheim, well known author and scholar on Russian and world affairs, will lecture on "Ideas of the Future" at 8:00 p.m. Thursday, October 14, in the Humanities-Library Auditorium at the University of California, San Diego.

Mr. Lichtheim is currently serving as Visiting Professor of History at Stanford University. His lecture at UCSD will be sponsored by the University's Committee for Arts and Lectures. It is free and open to the public.

Mr. Lichtheim has served as a fellow of the Research Institute on Communist Affairs at Columbia University in New York City and is the former editor of the quarterly publication "Soviet Survey." He is the author of the book "Marxism: An Historical and Critical Study."

He was born in Berlin, Germany, and studied at the University in Heidelberg. Since 1945 he has lived in London. Mr. Lichtheim is best known as a regular contributor and contributing editor for the American periodical "Commentary" and for his articles which appear regularly in the "New York Review of Books."
