

\$1.3 million in research grant awards made to various UCSD depts

Research grants totalling approximately \$1.3 million were made to various departments of the University of California, San Diego in the 45-day period ending May 31.

Most of the 22 grants were awarded by the National Science Foundation and the U.S. Department of Health, Education and Welfare. The U.S. Public Health Service made several substantial grants to the UCSD School of Medicine in the period.

The funding will support a wide variety of programs ranging from linguistics and economics to marine microbiology and molecular structure.

Several of the awards represent continued support of projects initiated in previous years.
