

Wind Ensemble from UCLA presents a program of band music in Sherwood Hall on March 21

Young soloists from the San Diego area will be featured when the Wind Ensemble of the University of California, Los Angeles, presents a program of band music in Sherwood Hall, Art Center in La Jolla, on Wednesday, March 21.

The group, led by Clarence Sawhill, Professor of Music at UCLA, consists of 44 players. The majority of them were with the UCLA Concert Band on its triumphant European tour last year.

Appearing as soloists will be Antoinette Mizisin., La Mesa, in Haydn's Oboe Concerto and Kenneth Schei, El Cajon, in a trumpet solo. Other San Diego area musicians in the group are Ward and Tom Beck, La Mesa, and Steve Davis, El Cajon.

The Wind Ensemble comes to San Diego under the auspices of the University's Committee for Intercampus Arts Exchange. Tickets are \$2.00 general admission; \$1.00 for students. They are available at the Art Center in La Jolla,, at University Extension., 1221 Fourth Avenue., and at the Cashier's Office on the San Diego campus.

The program will include Cherubini's "Anacreon," the Haydn Oboe Concerto, Persichetti's Symphony for Band, a trumpet solo by Mr. Schei, Debussy's Petite Suite, and selections from Gershwin's "Porgy and Bess." It will end with selected marches.
