

Faculty Lecture to be held in Sherwood Hall, Art Center in La Jolla on November 13

Stephen C. Pepper, famous scholar from the University of California, Berkeley, will speak on "Aspects of Appreciation" in a free public lecture at Sherwood Hall, Art Center in La Jolla, at 8:00 p.m., Monday evening, November 13.

Dr. Pepper is a member of both the Departments of Philosophy and Art at Berkeley. He is internationally known for his writings in aesthetics.

His talk is one of the Faculty Lectures jointly sponsored by the University of California, San Diego, and the Theatre and Arts Foundation of San Diego County.

Recently Dr. Pepper has been appointed to the University committee which is planning the curriculum in the humanities and the social sciences at the University of California, San Diego. He will make frequent trips to the campus in connection with this committee's work, says Herbert York, Chancellor at San Diego.
