

## First medical students to start classes

## September 9, 1968

The long and difficult climb to the degree of Doctor of Medicine will begin for the first time in San Diego County this month when 47 first-year medical students start classes in the new School of Medicine on the San Diego campus of the University of California.

Nearly 10 years of study and planning and millions of dollars for construction and equipment have gone into getting the UCSD School of Medicine into operation. The initial results will be seen at 8:30 a.m. Wednesday, September 25, when Dr. Clifford Grobstein, Dean of the School of Medicine, greets the charter class of medical students.

The students, including 30 from California, 15 from other states and 2 from foreign countries, will gather for the first time in the new \$15 million Basic Science Building. The building, the first construction project in the School of Medicine complex, will be only partially finished for this first meeting. Full completion is scheduled by the first of the year.

The class, 39 men and 8 women, will spend four full days in orientation before beginning class work on Monday, September 30. During the first day, the students will be introduced to the School of Medicine faculty and administration and will be briefed on general matters such as student government and organizations, registration, and housing. They will also be given a UCSD campus orientation.

At 8:00 a.m. Thursday, the students will begin a detailed look at the work which they will face during their first year. Dr. Grobstein will begin with an overview of the curriculum. He will be followed by members of the faculty who will give brief descriptions of the various departments in the School of Medicine.

At 2:00 p.m. Thursday, Dr. Elliott C. Lasser, Professor of Radiology, will lead a round table discussion of the curriculum beyond the first year of study.

The charter class will meet at 9:30 a.m. Friday in an initial class meeting designed to help them organ 4 ze a student government and various student organizations.

At 8:00 a.m. Saturday, the class will board a bus at the Basic Science Building and travel to University Hospital in the Hillcrest area of San Diego. They will meet in the outpatient lobby to begin a tour of the hospital with their advisors. The tour will be followed by a case presentation and discussion in the first floor auditorium.

At 3:00 p.m. Saturday, the charter class, the School of Medicine faculty and the nonacademic staff from the Dean's Office will meet for a beach party and picnic at Crown Point Beach.
