

10,000 Undergraduate Bulletin's distributed.

More than 10,000 copies of the Undergraduate Bulletin for the University of California, San Diego, have been distributed during the past two weeks to students, school officials, and others throughout the state. The 68-page bulletin lists undergraduate courses which will be offered during the fall, winter, and spring quarters, 1965-66.

John W. Brown, UCSD Registrar and Admissions Officer, said applications for admission to the University should be submitted by the tentative March 1 deadline. Admission requirements are uniform on all nine campuses of the University.

Brown said 173 undergraduate students are enrolled for the spring semester at UCSD. Next fall 600 freshmen students are expected to enroll in addition to 150 advanced standing students.

"We welcome applications," Brown said, adding that there is still time for many students to apply for admission.

Students who have already applied will be notified of their admission status by April 15, Brown said.
