

### **"Music in the Library"**

**November 27, 1972**

A gala "Music in the Library" afternoon will be presented at 4 p.m., Sunday, December 10, as part of a series of events sponsored by the Friends of the University of California, San Diego Library to acquaint the public with the library services available at UCSD.

Musical entertainment and refreshments will be available in the lobby of the Central University Library, and guests for the afternoon are free to wander through the library facilities.

A trio for cello, violin, and piano will present Mendelssohn's "Trio No. 1, Opus 49, in D Minor." Performers are John Haak, Assistant University Librarian, who will play the cello; Dr. John Goodkind, Associate Professor of Physics, who will play the violin; and Barbara (Mrs. Lawrence) Schneiderman, who will play the piano.

Prof. Jef Raskin of the UCSD Visual Arts Department has been very secretive about his music plans for the afternoon's festivities, but if his music is anything like his famed and fascinating room dividers, maze and toy show exhibitions, the guests are in for another successful surprise. In the past Raskin's recorder ensembles have been very well received.

President of the Friends of the UCSD Library is Mrs. Margaret (E. Laird) Landon of La Jolla. University Librarian is Melvin J. Voigt.

The \$5.5 million Central University Library, which has the appearance of a glass-encased flying saucer, had approximately 1 million visitors last year. The combined UCSD Library facilities will soon be acquiring their one-millionth volume.
