

Analysts appointed

Two new analysts have been appointed to the staff of the Office of Programming and Analytical Studies at the University of California, San Diego, it has been announced by Mr. Werner Lendenmann, director of the recently formed office.

They are Mr. Wayne D. Gray, a senior planning analyst on the Berkeley campus of the University of California for nearly two years, who will hold the same title at UCSD, and Mr. Robert W. Starkey, a systems analyst for the Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company in San Francisco, who will serve as an administrative analyst for UCSD.

The Office of Programming and Analytical Studies deals with the expected physical requirements of the campus based on growth projections; coordination of capital improvement programs; coordination of Federal facilities and equipment grant programs; preparation of long-range fiscal plans which include enrollment and staffing projections; and development of a management information system.

Gray was born in Everett, Washington. He received a bachelor's and master's degree in political science from the University of California, Berkeley after serving two years in the United States Army. He served as an assistant personnel analyst for the California State Department of Social Welfare from 1958 to 1960 and then for four years as assistant to the executive dean of Sacramento State College. Before joining the staff at Berkeley, Gray served as dean of administration for Saint Michael's College at the University of the Pacific.

At UCSD he will be concerned with programming academic buildings, preparation of Federal facilities and equipment grant proposals, and staff assistance for building advisory committees.

Starkey was born in Whittier, California. He received a bachelor's degree from Whittier College and a master's degree in finance from the University of Southern California. He has worked as a credit analyst and administrative assistant in the installment loan department for United California Bank in Los Angeles. He joined Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company in 1963 working in various departments as a supervisor and a systems analyst.

At UCSD Starkey will develop information systems and student and staff data to aid in the campus building program, workload analysis, fiscal planning, and management surveys.
