

Robert N. Berube named Director of Special Programs in the Development Office

Robert N. Berube, acting director of development at the University of California, Irvine and executive director of the UCI Foundation, has been named Director of Special Programs in the Development Office at the University of California, San Diego.

In his new position, Berube will work closely with the dean of the UCSD School of Medicine, the director of the University Hospital and the dean of the recently established Division of Engineering in developing programs aimed at increasing the amount of private financial support available to these units. One of his primary responsibilities will be the development of the Division of Engineering's Industrial Liaison Program which is designed to increase interaction between UCSD and the San Diego industrial community.

In addition, Berube will provide assistance to Ray Ramseyer, special assistant to the chancellor for development and executive director of the UC San Diego Foundation, in all areas of the university's fund raising programs.

Prior to his four years at UC Irvine, Berube established and managed Cornell University's Western Regional Development and Alumni office in Los Angeles from 1974 to 1979. A 1966 graduate of Cornell, Berube served four years as an Air Force officer and two years as executive assistant manager at the Village Green Resort in Oregon.

Berube, his wife, Sharon, an elementary school teacher, and their two children currently reside in Laguna Niguel.
