They are "Atomic and Nuclear Physics", taught by Dr. Keith A Breuckner, Professor of Physics, on Tuesday, from 4:30 to 6:00 p.m. and on Saturday, from 8:00 to 9:30 a.m., and "Thermodynamics, Kinetic Theory, Statistical Mechanics", taught by Dr. Walter Kohn, Professor of Physics, on Thursday, 4:30 to 6:00 p.m. and on Saturday, 9:30 to 11:00 a.m.

In addition, the Department is cooperating with University Extension in offering a graduate course, "Physical Metallurgy", taught by Dr. Massoud Simnad, General Atomic, on Wednesday evenings, at the La Jolla Campus.
