MOUNT HAGEN PATROL REPORT NO. 4/1973-74

Thank you for the above report forwarded with your covering memorandum 67-3-1 of 4th January, 1974.

The following are some comments concerning the format of the Report.

1. Originals of F.O.J.'s should be submitted with Patrol Reports and not copies as submitted.
2. In your 67-3-1 of 7th January, 1974, to Mr. Nam which offers some comments on his report you point out, under "commentary" his failings as to the correct format of the Report. I am surprised that at this time you did not return the Report to him to be correctly compiled; perhaps this was because the Report was already late. More importantly, however, you have not used the correct format yourself in that you have not made separate assessments as Assistant District Commissioner, on Sitreps 1, 2 and 3. I am therefore unable to forward these Sitreps on to our Headquarters.
3. In your patrol instructions you do not specify as to what subject matters for which you require Situation Reports.
4. The above matters are well covered in Headquarters Circulars 67-1-6 of 25th November, 1971 and 67-1-6 of 24th February, 1972. It is important that these instructions be followed in future.

General comments are as follows:-

1. The question arises as to how long ago this area was patrolled, and how experienced was the patrolling officer.

It is suggested that the Patrol Officer's role has become strange to some extent as a result of our poor efforts to communicate in general terms with the people. Our efforts have generally been in the law and order field, which is an unpopular one with nearby urban dwellers.

2. I would also suggest that it is a general rule in this country that the closer people are to civilisation and contact, the less responsible they become to direction and general co-operation.

3. I am not particularly disturbed over the poor attendances. Informal meetings with small groups is to be the approach in such sophisticated areas as the one patrolled. Patrolling officers should be well equipped with knowledge which is of interest to the people.

An informal type of patrol of this nature should be visited frequently by senior officers to encourage the people's interest; and more particularly if the area has been neglected.

4. The Assistant District Commissioner should enquire as to the activities of other Departments. The Patrol Officer becomes a communication for other Departments.
5. I do not agree that an additional vehicle is required for the area. As already discussed at an Assistant District Commissioners Conference it is preferable to walk and talk with groups of people rather than driving past them.
6. It has been fairly standard practice that Patrols should not work on Sundays.
7. Mr. Nami has not made any reference to having recorded unsettled disputes, or in fact if any disputes were dealt with, as per the patrol instructions.

Sitrep 'Political Aspects'

I am disappointed at the brief Political Education Section of the report particularly as the instructions gave this aspect some importance. Was the 8 Point Development Plan discussed?

Sitrep 'Economy'

The complaint of coffee buyers cheating the people is a long standing one - In the Mij area the Wahgi Council purchased scales which were set up at the main coffee buying points. A man with some education was used to ensure that the people were paid the correct price.

It would appear that the people expect D.A.S.F. officers to clear their coffee. I would be interested to know how many people have visited the Agricultural office and requested their assisted.

The attached report refers. F.O.J. and camping allowance claims are also attached.

The Manjim road is progressing very fast but the standard of construction is poor. The Rodina road is suffering from neglect through lack of use. Both roads require blasting for progress. I will pursue that matter from here.

My report on the Olga Co. is enclosed. Since I patrolled Mr Winchcombe has visited the area with an Administration Officer, who is submitting a further report on the matter. I understand that feelings have mellowed a little since his visit. I would consider this to be the case. I will see the people again in about a months time and see how they feel about it then. Pelling and Kuni are to visit the plantation in Saidor in about a months time.

The patrol was well recieved everywhere we went. An Officer from D.A.S.F. accompanied the patrol, carrying out Agricultural Extension work. They seem to be pushing coffee, citrus fruits and cardamoms. There were no problems throughout the area, and I am doing follow up work on a couple of P.H.D. matters and road worries.

At Rodina on 23rd May I spoke with Peling, Mak and Pank who are three of the four agents, (the fourth being Kumi) and a number of headmen from the area. They reiterated my previous information that they were not consulted about the matter, they did not know how much money was involved, some wanted their money back, and most were upset that the company was in Madang.

The history appears to be that originally Messrs. Butler and Winchcombe, persuaded them to withdraw their money from the Territory Loan, and invest in a local enterprise. They tried unsuccessfully to buy Tigi Plantation. They then tried to lease Govt. ground in the Lower Jimi, but were unsuccessful again. In January 1974 Butler and Peling went to Madang. From there they caught another plane to an unknown destination. About 14 miles from this airstrip Peling was shown a plantation growing coconuts and Kauri; and an area was set aside for tobacco. Peling then returned to Hagen.

Peling and the people believe that their money has been invested in this plantation although they are not sure if in fact they own it or not. They don't know where it is. They are all very concerned about the whole deal. Peling is also worried as the people are blaming him for the deal.

They made extensive comment of the fact that they would rather see the money invested locally. Butler has indicated that a dividend will be paid this year, but they weren't very sure of this.

I have advised the people I will make investigations into all aspects of the matter, and then get them to come and see me in Hagat, where I will try and clarify the position for them.
