January 26 Catherine Wagner and Martin Coreless Smith. Wagner is the author of *Macular Hole* and *Miss America*. Coreless-Smith is the author of *Nota, Complete Travels* and *Of Piscator*. Both poets teach at Boise State University.

February 10 Jordan Davis. Author of *Million Poems Journal*, Davis began hosting The Million Poems Show, a poetry talk show at the Bowery Poetry Club, in the fall of 2004.

February 16 Monica Youn. An entertainment lawyer living in Manhattan, Youn published her first book of poems, *Barter*, in 2003.
