
UCSD Medical Center Programs Rank Among The Nation's Best

he University of California, San Diego (UCSD) Medical Center is the only San Diego hospital that ranks among the best in the nation in six specialty areas in the 2007 *U.S. News and World Report* annual "Best Hospitals" issue. The magazine, which ranks the top 50 hospitals in several different specialties, will be on the newsstands Monday, July 16.

In the 2007 report, UCSD Medical Center is ranked:

- > 8th in Respiratory Diseases
- > 18th in Rheumatology
- \Rightarrow 30th in Kidney Disease
- > 30th in Gynecology
- → 39th in Cancer
- → 50th in Ear, Nose, Throat



"UCSD Medical Center serves the community with excellent care, leading edge research and education," said Richard Liekweg, Chief Executive Officer UCSD Medical Center-Hillcrest and the UCSD Thornton Hospital. "This national recognition of our specialty services demonstrates the importance of 'academic medicine' in developing and delivering state-of-the-art health care."

Only 176 hospitals nationally are listed in this year's issue, which rates hospitals in 16 different specialties.

In this year's "Best Graduate Schools" edition (released March 31), *U.S. News* ranked the UCSD School of Medicine 5th in the nation among public medical schools (14th among all U.S. medical



schools), with its AIDS program ranked 6th, and Drug and Alcohol Abuse ranked 10th.

In addition to its two hospitals, UCSD provides primary and specialty ambulatory care at outpatient centers in Hillcrest, La Jolla, and Scripps Ranch, and ophthalmology services at the Shiley Eye Center in La Jolla.

The UCSD Moores Cancer Center z is the region's only National Cancer Institute-designated Comprehensive Cancer Center, and the University will break ground on the Sulpizio Family Cardiovascular Center Z adjacent to the Thornton Hospital this fall.
