Research grants totalling \$1,484,000 granted in August

Research grants and contracts totalling \$1,484,000 were awarded in August to members of the faculty of the University of California, San Diego.

The awards will finance projects in the fields of anthropology, psychology, oceanography, biology, chemistry, medicine and physics.

A grant from the National Institute of Mental Health will subsidize a study titled "Crime in a Highland Guatemala Community." A three-year contract with the National Aeronautics and Space Administration makes available \$775,000 for a space-physics project involving radiation studies.

More than 700 projects funded by grants or contracts now are under way on the UCSD campus. The majority of these are financed by federal agencies, with the National Science Foundation and the Department of Health, Education and Welfare underwriting the greatest number of programs.

More than 200 of the projects are being subsidized by private gifts and contracts.
