This Officer accompanied the patrol from 1/10/74 to 11/10/74. He adapted to this very undemiliar environment without any problems, and has settled down to complete the patrol solo. He displays a flair for developmental work, and has developed a very commendable enthing relationship with his patrol staff and the people he is assisting.

HAR.

The patrol assisted the Maddines and YOGONIA people with their represent. All of the groups writed well, and the road from Middines to Mandines and Kinghiya and Kinghiya to Yogonia chould prove completely relitationates the set. Unfortunately there is a gap between Manganes and Kinghilas that is going to cause problems. This section is in the Sebing Sub District, and the people pay tox to the Makag Lotal Government Council. This council has not allocated any REP locals to the road, and the people display no interest in doinh weekly maintenance. There are Doggs patches near TUKESENIA that will probably put this road out very shortly.

What it meeds is a co-ordinated effort by the Lagaip and Wahly councils. The road is important. It serves about 4,000 people, opens up a rich pyrethrum and polato producing area, and leads directly to the proposed Samu Ltd bulk store at Mamaides. It also gives access to the PURUS grasslands through YUGUMA, and in about 2 works time will be on alternate route to beingen through MANEPAP

when the WANEPAP - YOUMAN road is through (mid December 1974) the Mamaides - Yoganda road will be much more of value to the Wabag people than the Legalps, and should warrant the attention of the Papag Council.

MINUR RES PURSS.

The base camp at Mamaides continues to make slow progress. With the virtual completion of the teacher's house at Talumo, we now have mough artisans, but se boual materials are in cronic short supply. our costs have already exceeded the estimates, but as it is certain that many materials will not be delivered this is of no great concern at the movent.

The contractor has commenced construction of the Police Station and 5 DRO's.

This Officer accompanied the patrol from 1/10/74 to 11/30/74. He adepted to this very unfamiliar environment without any problem, and has settled down to complete the patrol solo, he displays a flair for developmental work, and has developed a very commendable marking relationship with his patrol staff and the people he is assisting.

RIP.

The patrol essisted the MARKHES and YORKHUA people with their road project. All of the groups worked well and the road from MARKHES to HAMBHES and KINAPULAN to YOURNDA should prove completely reliable throughout the wet. Unfortunately there is a gas between Namoures and Kinapulae that is going to cause problems. This section is in the Babog Sub District, and the people pay tax to the Mabag Local Government Council. This council has not allocated any RIP funds to the road, and the people display no interest in doing weekly maintenance. There are boggy patches near TIKISENTA that will probably out this road out very shortly.

What it needs is a co-ordinated effort by the Lagaip and Mahag councils. The road is important. It serves about 4,000 people, opens up a rich pyrethrum and potato producing area, and leads directly to the proposed Samu Ltd Lulk store at Mamaides. It also gives access to the PLMAS grasslands through YCANNA, and in about 2 works time will be an alternate route to Laiagam through MANEPAP.

When the WANEPAP - YUGONDA road is through (sid December 1974) the Namaides - Yogonda road will be such more of value to the Wabag people han the Lagaips, and should warrant the attention of the Wabag Council.

MINKS MEN WORKS.

The base camp at Mamaides continues to make slow progress. With the virtual completion of the teacher's house at Taluma, we now have enough artisans, but as usual materials are in cronic short hupply. Larour costs have already exceeded the estimates, but as it is certain that many materials will not be delivered this is of o great concern at the moment.

The contractor has commenced construction of the Police Station and 5 IM2's.

Census was conducted at KIMAPULAM and YOKKWDA by Mr. Russell - Pell. who will report separately on this.
