FIFTH ANNUAL QUEST INTERNATIONAL '90

The Opportunities Abroad Office of the University of California, San Diego's International Center is busily preparing for its fifth annual "Quest International," to be held at the International Center on Friday, October 19 from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Quest International is the Center's annual study/work/travel abroad information fair. This year's Quest will bring representatives from over 30 international programs to UCSD to meet with interested students, staff, faculty, and community members.

A wide variety of U.S. university study abroad programs including the University of California's Education Abroad Program, foreign universities, intensive language programs, academic internship programs, volunteer work programs, and paid work abroad programs will be represented at the fair. These programs offer students study and work options both during the academic year and during the summer months.

International employers will also be featured at the exhibit as many students who have study and travel experience abroad are interested in pursuing international careers after their graduation. According to the International Center, approximately 130 international employers have been contacted soliciting their involvement in the fair.

As part of Quest, there will also be an international lunch from 11:30 to 1:30 p.m. for just \$2.00. The lunch will be cosponsored by the Council on International Educational Exchange (CIEE) and Council Travel.

All community members and students interested in study, work, or travel abroad are encouraged to participate. For those interested in investigating opportunities abroad for themselves or for family members, Quest provides an excellent opportunity to meet directly with program sponsors and to get first hand information.

Quest will be co-sponsored this year by the Opportunities Abroad Office, Career Services Center, Revelle Language House, and Fifth College at UCSD.
