

Bach Aria Group to appear in Sherwood Hall May 25.

The Bach Aria Group of La Jolla, considered one of the finest locally sponsored music groups in Southern California, is scheduled to perform at 8:30 p.m. Tuesday, May 25, in Sherwood Hall, La Jolla.

Unreserved seating is \$1.00 for UCSD students and \$2.00 for general admission.

Sponsored as part of the California Artists Series by the Committee for Arts and Lectures of the University of California, San Diego, the group will perform four Bach Cantatas.

The first half of the concert will consist of Cantata No. 159, "Wir gehen hinauf gen Jerusalem," and Cantata No. 84, "Ich bin vergnugt mit meinem Gluke." Following the intermission, the group will perform Cantata No 53, "Schlage Doch, gewunschte Stunde," a cantata in one movement for alto, strings and chimes, and Cantata No. 157, "Ich lasse dich nicht, du sergnest mich denn."
