I also submit list of tools already returned to the
Volcan Company and list of equipment on hand at Lake Hodges
Dam that, in my judgment, will not be needed by the San Dieguito
Mutual Water Company.

With reference to the small pumps, when the house for
caretaker is built at the Dam, we may require a pump to put
water in a tank, but not knowing the plans of the Company in
this respect, I did not recommend the purchase of the pumps.

Dear Sir:-

As per your request I have had Mr. Green make inventory and report on equipment that was at Lake Hodges Dam.

I enclose herewith inventory of equipment remaining new at Lake Hodges Dam. Also list of equipment sent to Santa Fe Ranch for McFadden's use.

Also list showing articles not otherwise accounted for. This list includes the few articles used and worn out by Bent Brothers. Also those items worn out by Mr. Detrick and men. By reference to this you will note that but few items were used by Bent Brothers. When they came on the work they borrowed blacksmith shop, picks and shovels, drills and a few items along that line. These were returned to the Company within two months after starting work and the only article they used for any length of time was the car. This was used for 2 or 3 months when it was abandoned.

Most of the items lost and worn out were used by the crew working for Mr. Detrick. You will note that there are several items on the list which do not appear on the original and they are replacements and articles bought for use.
