UCSD INTERNATIONAL CENTER HOSTS "QUEST INTERNATIONAL '93"

Representatives from more than 40 international study programs will meet with students, faculty and community members from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m., Friday, Oct. 22, for the eighth annual "Quest International '93," a study abroad fair, in the International Center plaza at the University of California, San Diego.

UCSD's Quest International fair will be the next to the last event out of 12 such study abroad fairs being held this fall in California. More than 1500 people are expected to attend the International Center's event.

Exhibitors will include a wide variety of study abroad programs sponsored by United States and foreign universities. Also represented will be intensive language and internship programs, and paid and volunteer overseas work programs. The University of California's Education Abroad Program also will be represented.

In addition to the exhibitors, the International Center will hold its International Cafe luncheon at noon, on one of the center's patios. The cafe is a regular weekly feature of the International Center, served for \$2.50, and sponsored each week by a community organization or business. The Oct. 22 cafe will be sponsored by Council Travel.
