

"San Diego Inside: A Look at the County's Future" series presented

Leadership, growth and commerce in San Diego will be discussed by local notables in a three-part series called "San Diego Inside: A Look at the County's Future," to be presented at the University of California, San Diego.

The forums will begin at 7:30 p.m. Thursday, Feb. 1, 8 and 15, in the Mandeville Auditorium. Cost of the series is \$9; UCSD faculty and staff, \$7.50. Single tickets cost \$4; \$1.50 for all students.

The series is sponsored by the San Diego Inside newsletter and the UC San Diego Mandeville Lectures program. Tickets can be purchased by mail or in person at the UCSD Central Box Office, 452-4559.

San Diego Mayor Pete Wilson, U.S. Attorney Mike Walsh and businessman O. Morris Sievert will discuss leadership in the opening program. Growth and development in the county will be the topic of the second program, featuring developer Steve Drogin, real estate expert Sanford Goodkin and County Supervisor Roger Hedgecock.

Dick Davis of the Economic Development Corporation, Assemblyman Jim Mills and Gerald Trimble of the Centre City Development Corporation will conclude the series with a forum on commerce in San Diego. Dick Carlson, executive vice president of San Diego Federal Savings and Loan, will moderate the series.
