

All-University Faculty Lecture, Jack F. Evernden, UCB, will speak on "The Time-Scale of Human Cultural Evolution"

New clues to the ancient history of man will be discussed in a scientific lecture at the University of California, San Diego, on Monday afternoon, March 18.

Jack F. Evernden, Professor of Geology, University of California, Berkeley, will speak on "The Time-Scale of Human Cultural Evolution" at Sumner Auditorium at 4:15 p.m.

His is one in the series of All-University Faculty Lectures, which bring distinguished faculty members of the University to speak on different campuses.

Evernden has been working with the potassium-argon method of dating layers of volcanic rocks. Ancient tools and human bones have been found in such rocks in Africa, Italy, and Java.
