Mr. Mores

Dear Sir

From my arrival at San Antonio
from Santa Tomas I was informed that Messa the
Concepcion had been in San Diego and told you that
he had a Copper Mine in San Antonio but I
informed you that it is gold. He found a mine
but it is in the limits of the mine Gold La
Luz belonging to W. A. Winder and myself
and others I had a talk with Messa and convinced
him that the Mine ~~was~~ belongs to me but I
declared Messa one of the ~~owners~~ owners of said mine
so if he has made any Contract with you it
all right for he owns three shares of said mine
and I think it is one of the best ones in
the Country and from what he told me abo
ut some things he received from you I consider
that you as one of the owners with him he
told me that Daniel would be sworn to see
it in 9 or 10 days but it is not worth it
unless he wants to take a ride for if Messa
told you that it is a gold mine and a rich one
he only told you the truth Messa told me to
rite to you and in forming you what had

happend so that you wite not that
hard of time he told me that his only
fir mos that he had got some things from
you and he wanted you to be sadespide and
I think its all rite. so no mos at present
