To Thomas Hall Esq. Greeting

By Virtue of the Power & Authority to me derived from His most Excellent
Majesty George the Second, of Great Britain France & Ireland King & of Jamaica
and Defender of the Faith &c. And reporting especial Trust & Confidence in your
Experience, Courage, Conduct & Fidelity & Skill in Military Affairs, I have Constituted
& appointed by these Presents do constitute & appoint you the said Thomas
Hall Esq. to be Lieutenant of Captain Samuel Bennett Troop of Horse
in the Regiment of Horse raised or to be raised within this Island, whereof
John M'Lean Esq. is Colonel. You are therefore as Lieutenant to take the said
Troop into your care & charge, & duly to receive the inferior Officers & Troopers
thereof in Arms &c. use your best endeavours to keep them in good Order &
Discipline, and all inferior Officers & Troopers belonging to the said Troop, as
being strictly commanded to obey you as their Lieutenant, and you are to
observe & follow all such Orders & Directions, as you shall from time to time receive
from His Majesty myself or other your Superior Officers, according to the
Rules of War & Trust hereby referred in you. Given under my hand and
Seal at Arms at St. Jago de la Vega the first day of October in the fifth
Year of His Majesty's Reign Annoq. Domini 1717.
