By His Excellency Edward Trelawny Esq: Captain-General, Governor & Commander in Chief of His Majesty's Island of Jamaica & the Territories thereon depending in America, Chancellor & Vice Admiral of the same.

To Thomas Hall Esq: Greeting

By Virtue of the Power & Authority to me derived from His most Excellent Majesty George the Second, of Great Britain France & Ireland King & of Jamaica & his Defender of the Faith &c. And reporting especial Trust & Confidence in your Experience Courage Conduct & fidelity & Skill in Military Affairs I have constituted & appointed by these Presents to constitute & appoint you the said Thomas Hall Esq: to be Lieutenant of Captain Samuel Barnett Troop of Horse in the Regiment of Horse raised or to be raised within this Island, whereof John Allen Esq: is Colonel. You are therefore as Lieutenant to take the said Troop into your care & charge, & duly to exercise the inferior Officers & Troopers thereof in Arms & to use your best endeavours to keep them in good Order & Discipline, and all inferior Officers & Troopers belonging to the said Troop as duly strictly commanded to obey you as their Lieutenant, and you are to observe & follow all such Orders & Directions, as you shall from time to time receive from His Majesty my self or other your superior Officer according to the Rules of War & Tidit hereby imposed in you. Given under my hand and Seal at Arms at St. Jago de la Vega the first day of October in the fifteenth Year of His Majesty's Reign Anno Domini 1741,
