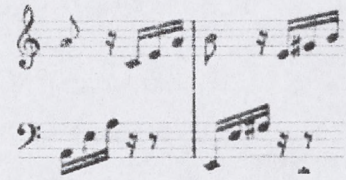

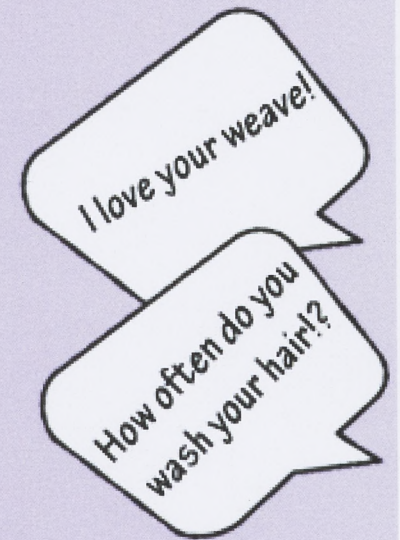
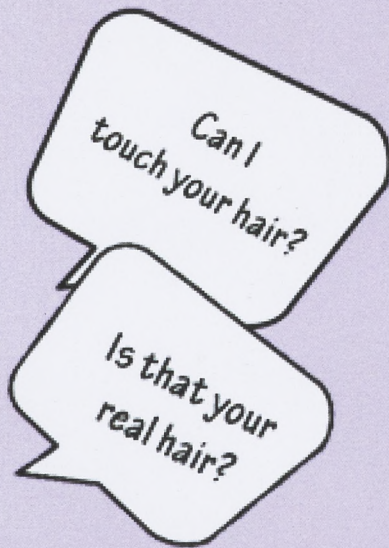
The Root of the Matter:
