

## **Appointment of Quelda Wilson announced**

The appointment of Dr. Quelda Marie Wilson as assistant vice chancellor-staff personnel management at the University of California, San Diego has been announced by Bernard Sisco, vice chancellor of administration. She replaces Dale Cobb, who retired.

Wilson previously served as assistant academic affirmative action coordinator and director of summer session at the university. She holds a doctorate in higher education administration from the University of Michigan and a master's degree in English from Marquette University.

Wilson had extensive administrative experience before coming to UC San Diego in 1973. As assistant professor of education at St. Louis University and chairwoman of the department of higher education, she taught graduate courses in administration and was responsible for program development.

She also served as executive secretary for a university-wide effort to plan and evaluate programs at the university. From 1968-69 she was president of St. Benedict College in Ferdinand, Indiana and before that she was dean of students at the college.

Originally from Evansville, Indiana, Wilson currently resides in Cardiff.
