BACKGROUND: The Board of Regents-of the University of California is expected to approve the proposed design for a \$2.5 million university theater at the monthly board meeting Friday morning in Los Angeles. The 500-seat theater is a joint project of the foundation and the university, with funding raised by the foundation and maintenance and repairs provided by the university. The theater will be built on three acres of land on the UC San Diego campus at the northeast intersection of La Jolla Village Drive and Torrey Pines Road. UC San Diego Chancellor William McElroy, Foundation President Ewart Goodwin Jr. and representatives of the foundation and the university will attend the news conference, and press releases and photographs of the theater model and the interior design will be supplied.
